


- Location: West Loading dock, 1601 Airport Road NE.
- Standard size, 6 bays, all to the standard of what you would find in a warehouse capable of accepting large shipments of freight. This is the location where all large deliveries are received, so the Dockmaster has informed me that they will be able to handle large shipments of furniture.
- Freight Elevator: the freight elevator is down a corridor and through a controlled door in the Basement Level, so I will need to escort delivery drivers and their crews/helpers. The dimensions of the freight elevator are:

o 60" wide x 80" high x 108" deep (9 ft. in depth), weight restriction is 2720kg (5,996.5 pounds).

- The freight elevator is located in Concourse A and connects the Basement Level with the Mezzanine Level.


