#### **QUESTION 1:**

Given the countries in which CoE is active, we expect that interviews (or other data collection) with stakeholders may need to be conducted in English, French, and Portuguese. Is this correct? Will the evaluation team require capacity in any other languages in order to successfully carry out this evaluation?

#### ANSWER:

The CoE did not cover any Lusophony country, so Portuguese is not necessary. However, due to the fact that CoE has provided substantial support to Senegal, Guinea and Cameroun, it will be critical that the consultant is fully fluent in French.

## QUESTION 2:

Our firm often prepares proposals in Slide Docs format (landscape-style documents created in PowerPoint and submitted in PDF format). Would this be acceptable to IDRC, or would a traditional Word document be preferred?
