

**Amendment number 002 is issued to address the following:  
All changes appear in blue.**

1. In Section 2, Overview, **DELETE** the following words:

“An expert jury is being assembled for this competition. The jury will play an advisory role to the Minister of Canadian Heritage, as minister responsible for commemorative monuments on federal lands in Canada’s Capital Region, and the Minister of Veterans Affairs, who will be jointly responsible for endorsing the jury’s selection of the winning design.”

and **REPLACE** them by the following words:

“An expert jury is being assembled for this competition. **The Minister of Canadian Heritage, as minister responsible for commemorative monuments on federal lands in Canada’s Capital Region, and the Minister of Veterans Affairs, will be jointly responsible for endorsing the jury’s selection of the winning design.**”

2. In Section 6, Design Competition Process, Jury Authority and Responsibilities, **DELETE** the following words:

“The jury will play an advisory role to the Minister of Canadian Heritage, as minister responsible for commemorative monuments on federal lands in Canada’s Capital Region, and the Minister of Veterans Affairs, who will be jointly responsible the selection of the winning design, based on the jury’s recommendation.”

and **REPLACE** them by the following words:

“**The Minister of Canadian Heritage, as minister responsible for commemorative monuments on federal lands in Canada’s Capital Region, and the Minister of Veterans Affairs, will be jointly responsible for endorsing the jury’s selection of the winning design.**”

3. In Section 2, Overview, **DELETE** the following words:

“This national design competition is open to design teams composed of professional, practising artists, landscape architects, architects and other urban design professionals. While PCH welcomes the participation of international competitors, each team must be led by a Canadian citizen.”

and **REPLACE** them by the following words:

“This national design competition is open to design teams composed of professional, practising artists, landscape architects, architects and other urban design professionals. While PCH welcomes the participation of international competitors, each team must be led by a Canadian citizen **or a permanent resident.**”

4. In Section 7, Eligibility, **DELETE** the following words:

“Design teams must meet the following mandatory requirements to be eligible for this competition:

- The design team lead is a Canadian citizen. “

and **REPLACE** them by the following words:

“Design teams must meet the following mandatory requirements to be eligible for this competition:

- The design team lead is a Canadian citizen [or a permanent resident](#). “

5. In Annex A, Evaluation Criteria for Phase 1, Mandatory Criteria, **DELETE** the following words:

“The design team lead is a Canadian citizen.”

and **REPLACE** them by the following words:

“The design team lead is a Canadian citizen [or a permanent resident](#).”

6. In Annex B, Additional Information, Integrity Provisions, **DELETE** the following words:

“Finalist design teams must comply with the Government of Canada’s *Code of Conduct for Procurement*. PCH reserves the right to verify the information and references submitted. By submitting a bid, each design team certifies that it is aware that PCH may request additional information, certifications, consent forms and other evidentiary elements proving identity or eligibility, including proof of citizenship.”

and **REPLACE** them by the following words:

“Finalist design teams must comply with the Government of Canada’s *Code of Conduct for Procurement*. PCH reserves the right to verify the information and references submitted. By submitting a bid, each design team certifies that it is aware that PCH may request additional information, certifications, consent forms and other evidentiary elements proving identity or eligibility, including proof of citizenship [or permanent residency](#).”
