Insert:

The bidder must have three (3) years of demonstrated experience performing technical assessments on maritime or nautical vessels that adhere to the Transport Canada Standard TP1332 : Construction Standards for Small Vessels (2010) in the last ten (10) years.”

Question 001:

Will P.Eng. with 20+ years of experience with marine surveying be acceptable to perform the work?

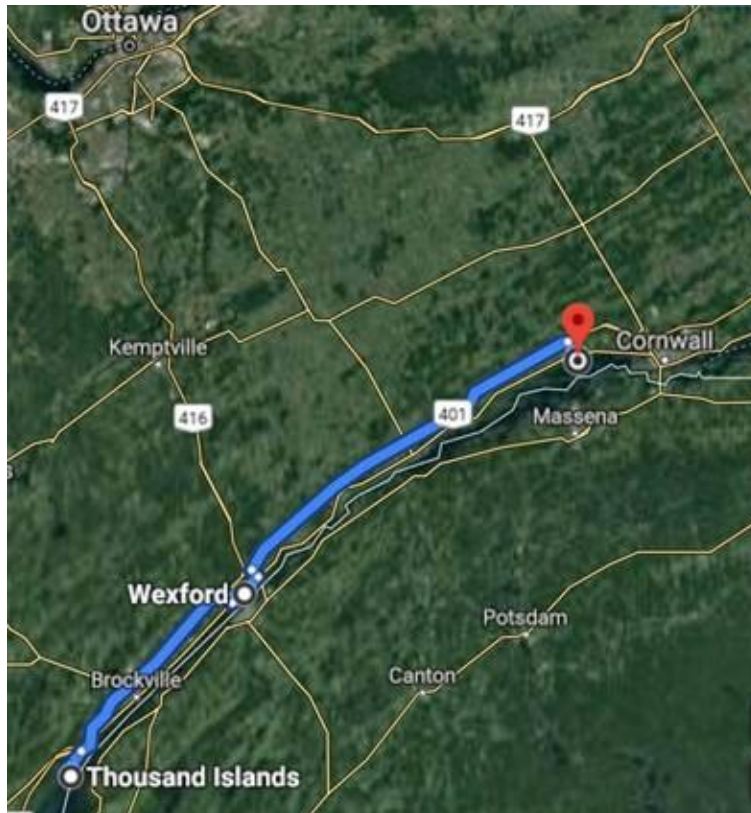
Answer 001:

It is the Contractors responsibility to ensure personnel is qualified to do the work. It is the Contractors responsibility to ensure they comply with the mandatory technical criteria from 1.7.1.1 of the Request for Proposal “The bidder must have three (3) years of demonstrated experience performing technical assessments on maritime or nautical vessels that adhere to the Transport Canada Standard TP1332 : Construction Standards for Small Vessels (2010) in the last ten (10) years.”

That being said we believe an individual with 20+ years of experience would be able to complete the work.

Question 002:

Could you please confirm that the vessels are (roughly) located as shown below?



Answer 002:

The Wexford's Vessel: Yes.

The Thousand Islands' vessel (Long Sault – close to Cornwall) ; Yes.

The Lake of Wood's vessel : No. The lat/lon of each vessel is in the respective SOW (Page 14). 45

Question 003:

Are the vessels accessible? From the photos in the RFP it looks like some of them are anchored away from shore. Will access over water / ice be possible and provided or do we have to arrange?

Answer 003:

They are accessible over water /ice. The contractor has to provide his own facilities and equipment to safety access to the vessel.
