**Question #007**

**Question #007:**

For CPR-1 of the Corporate Point-Rated Criteria, there is a restriction that a reference contract used to meet Part A and Part B of CPR-1 must be different from the reference contract used in the response to Part A and Part B, respectively of CM-1. Likewise, for CPR-2 to CPR-6 and CPR-8, there are similar restrictions in relation to their corresponding Corporate Mandatory Criteria. However, for CPR-7, CPR-9 and CPR-10 there are no restrictions.

For the Corporate Criteria, it is requested that Canada allow the use of reference contracts used to meet the Corporate Mandatory Criteria to be also used to meet any or all Corporate Point-Rated Criteria without any restrictions.

**Answer #007:**

For each of CPR-1 to CPR-6 and CPR-8, there exists a corresponding nearly identical Corporate Mandatory Criteria. To meet, for example CM-3, the Bidder may use a reference contract that is the same as a reference contract used to respond to other corporate mandatory criteria. However, for CPR-3, the corresponding point-rated criteria to CM-3, there is a restriction that the reference contract must be different from that used in the response to CM-3. This restriction is necessary because the requirements under CPR-3 are nearly identical to those under CM-3.

Mandatory criteria set a baseline of required experience. Point-rated criteria allow for points to be awarded to those Bidders who have more than the baseline of required experience. As an intent of the point-rated criteria is to further differentiate Bidders' experience and capability, additional reference contracts for requirements nearly identical to those in the Corporate Mandatory Criteria will be appreciated with points.

For CPR-7, CPR-9 and CPR-10, no restrictions are in place because there exist no corresponding Corporate Mandatory Criteria with similar requirements.

Given the foregoing, the Corporate Criteria remain unchanged
