Amendment 1

Question 1:

Could you confirm that the cone top is the 200mm tall x 273mm dia. and that per lot you only require five (5) and not fifteen (15), allowing for one on each buoy and five (5) spares?

Answer 1:

Cone top is 200mm tall x 273mm dia. (Section 6-D and 6-E, Dwg FA-3005).

Question 2:

Please provide material specifications on the 24" pipe and the 10" pipe. We have pricing for astm a252 gr 3 bare . Also, just to be clear this order would be 50 Buoys and 25 cone tops (total) going to 3 destinations.

Answer 2:

ASTM 252 is not acceptable as ASTM A242 is the standard spec for high strength and weather resistant steel and is required for the purpose of these buoys.

2.1 Materials

.1 Steel Plate:

.1 All steel plates used in buoy construction shall conform to either:

- .1 CSA G40.20/40.21, grade 350W or
- .2 ASTM A242 or
- .3 ASTM A36

As per Dwg FA-3005

- Item 6 - 10" pipe – Schedule 20
- Item 7 – 10" pipe – Schedule 40
- Item 10 – 24" pipe – 6mm wall minimum (Schedule 20 will be accepted)

The order will be for 50 buoys and 25 cone tops going to 3 destinations.

Question 3:

Can you tell me why you don't want the same quantity of the cone tops and buoys?

Answer 3:

Not all buoys will require a cone top when in use, only those placed in unlit starboard locations.

Question 4:

Can you confirm that sandblast and paint are not required?

Answer 4:

Not applicable. Product will be coated and painted after receipt.

Question 5:

Can you tell me if the Cone Tops asking are parts #18 with 2,3,13 and 4 ?

Answer 5:

Cone tops are identified on Drawing FA-3005 as part numbers 18, 2, 3, 4 and 13.

Question 6:

Could you confirm that the cone top is the 200mm tall x 273mm dia. and that per lot you only require five (5) and not fifteen (15), allowing for one on each buoy and five (5) spares?

Answer 6:

The cone top is 200mm tall x 273mm dia.

For every ten (10) buoys (1 Lot) that are ordered, the following numbers must apply:

- Ten (10) 17' spar buoys, and
- Five (5) cone tops, not fifteen (15) cone tops

Question 7:

A key question we have is, "Is there a drawing for the cone?"

It asks for 10 buoys and 5 cone tops but it never specifies what the cone top is. With the drawing attached is it the top component from 6-E (8-C highest piece)?

Answer 7:

The optional cone top is identified on Dwg FA-3005 in Section 6-E and Detail 8-C.

Question 8:

We're reviewing F5502-190172 and wondering why the optional 1.2 of Annex B doesn't have quantities listed like as in 1.1 for the Firm Requirement for Items 2, 3, 4? On page 15 Items 2, 3, 4 are blank. Would you be able to say why that is?

Answer 8:

The optional delivery quantity locations are unknown so the evaluation is using "1" as the estimated quantity for each location.

Please note the following correction:

Action:

The following paragraph stating “For evaluation purposes, the delivery cost for items 1 – 3 will be added at a Firm Lot Price using one (1) as an estimated quantity.” is deleted and replaced with the following paragraph: “

“For evaluation purposes, the delivery cost for items 2 – 4 will be added at a Firm Lot Price using one (1) as an estimated quantity.”

Additional Note:

1. With regards to ANNEX C - M1, the bidder may provide the buoy manufacturer’s CWB certification as the requested proof, for example if a sub-contractor is being used. However, it must be submitted with the bid or provided within two days upon request.
2. Please note that Visa has replaced Mastercard as a potential form of payment by the client department.
3. Faxed bids WILL be accepted provided they are received prior to the closing date and time. Fax number is (902)496=5016.
