Solicitation Amendment No. **002**

I. This solicitation is hereby amended to provide the following questions and answers

Q5. Page 2, Part 1, General Information - Would the crown consider adding a Canadian Content clause, as there are at least three known night vision companies based in Canada that can offer equal or better to the requested Product specification?

A5.No, the requirement meets the NAFTA threshold therefore must conform to NAFTA rules and regulations.

Q6.Page 13, 6.14 Warranty Period. - 1-year (12 months) warranty is industry standard. Would the crown consider accepting a standard 1-year manufacturer warranty?

A6. Yes, we agree. We have a minimum of one year standard warranty; it would be better if night vision tubes could be 3-5 years warranty.

Q7.Page 14, Annex "A", Statement of Requirement, 1.3 Field of View (FOV) - Would the crown consider accepting a 40° FOV as well, which is today's industry's standard? Please note that 5° degrees less of Field of View will significantly affect the operational effectiveness of the User. 35 degrees may be from an outdated statement of requirement.

A7.Yes, 35%-40% is acceptable.

Q8.Page 14, Annex "A", Statement of Requirement, 1.7 Waterproof - IP 65 is a Commercial Standard classification – it is respectfully proposed that the Waterproof shall be according to the MIL-STD-810G

A8. It should have a minimum of IP65 or better.

Q9.Page 14, Annex "A", Statement of Requirement, 1.8, Shockproof – Withstanding a fall of at least 1M isn't a recognised standards and doesn't give the parameters on how this test would be performed. It is respectfully proposed that the system shall meet MIL-STD-810G requirements, which includes a 1-meter drop test.

A9. Agree with the proposed changes.

Q10. Page 14, Annex "A", Statement of Requirement, 1.9, Operating Temperature – -40 to +40 degree Celsius isn't a recognised standard and doesn't give parameters on how it would be tested. It is respectfully proposed that the system shall meet MIL-STD-810G requirements, which includes a temperature test of 55°C and a low temperature test of -40°C

A10. Agree with the proposed changes.

Q11.Page 14, Annex "A", Statement of Requirement, 1.11, Headgear – Can the crown provide more clarification on constitutes a chin guard?

A11. Normally, the chin guard aids in the weight distribution of the device when using the head gear.

Q12. Page 14, Annex "A", Statement of Requirement, 1.11, Headgear – Could the crown consider including that the Head Gear shall be VAS Shroud enabled". The VAS shroud is industry standard and would permit both the Monocular and head gear to be compatible with other industry products.

A12. Agree with the proposed changes.

Q13. Page 14, Annex "A", Statement of Requirement, 1.12, Autogain – Can the crown confirm that "standard" is meant to mean that Autogain systems will only be accepted?

A13. Yes, only Autogain systems will be accepted as it is necessary to eliminate flare-up when light is projected toward the monoscope.

Q14. Page 14, Annex "A", Statement of Requirement, 1.13, Night Vision Core - Not all Image Intensifier tubes (IIT) use "generation" as a classification. Would the crown consider accepting Echo, 4G and XR technology as well?

A14. Tubes would require to be equivalent or greater to Generation 3 specs.

Q15. Page 14, Annex "A", Statement of Requirement, 1.14, Figure of Merit - With the advancement of image intensifier tubes over the years, would the crown consider accepting a FOM higher than 1799? if not could they explain why the FOM has a limit of 1799?

A15. Yes, would accept higher than 1799.

Q16. Page 14, Annex "A", Statement of Requirement, 1.18, Carrying Case – A carrying case may be considered a soft nylon bag, while the transportation case, which houses the system with the carrying bag, is typically hard plastic with padding inside. Can the crown confirm that they only desire the hard plastic transportation case without the soft carrying bag?

A16. Yes, only hard plastic case as they offer greater protection from the elements while being transported.

Q17. Is a 3X, 5X or both lenses a requirement for the deliverables, or are they considered optional?

A17. One (1) standard lens AND one (1) minimum 3X Magnification lens are required.

Q18. Please clarify if the requested Night Vision monoculars are subjected to Control Goods Program?

A18. No, the requested Night Vision Monoculars are not subject to the Controlled Goods Program.
