A. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q33 Our organization specialises in building restoration. However we have never completed any historic buildings. We are interested in bidding this job but I'm afraid we may not pass the experience qualification. Are we able to use other projects that are not Historical structures? **A33** All submissions will be evaluated based on the criteria in the Invitation to Tender.

1.1. Re.: 1.2 HERITAGE CONSERVATION

1.1.1. In reference to .2 ... "10 specific standards will be followed as outlined in the Standards and Guidelines of Historic Places in Canada..."

1.1.1.1. Please identify which 10 specific standards will be followed. There are only 7 mentioned in this section of the specifications and there are 14 standards in the Standards and Guidelines of Historic Places in Canada.

A34 All consideration for these Standards and Guidelines has been included in the design, the Contractor is provided with this information in order to be aware of the impact of all work being done on this building. Any of the Standards and Guidelines could become relevant, but the other 3 specifically noted for this work are 6, 8, and 14.

1.4.1.2. Please advise how long the consultant requires for review.

A37 Reviews will be completed by the Departmental Representatives and Consultants as quickly as is possible upon receipt. Due to the varied designs and submittals that are required on this project, we cannot provide a guaranteed timeline for all documentation.
