Questions:

- Q1) Would the use of a wireless 4G modem be allowed at the sites in the equipment room?
- Q2) I understand that the Institutions do not want to pay for the monthly internet/telco line costs but as the head end locations are within Corrections Canada property it is perhaps impossible for an outside third party to order an internet connection that would be set up within the property. Is there a way to work together where the order could be done by CSC and either the monthly cost paid direct by the winning bidder or rebated on the monthly invoice? Currently several of the Institutions have phone lines in place for the existing program guide but a dedicated internet connection would be the ideal solution especially for remote maintenance.

Answers:

A1 & 2) The Statement of Work – 1.7.1 states: "Television signal services that is a "one-way" signal without the possibility of a "cable modem" making outside contact with the Internet". From a technical perspective, both questions indicate external connectivity with the internet and would not meet the standard outlined in the statement of work.
