This amendment, No. 002, is raised to respond to vendor questions and amend solicitation EV385-201983/A, as follows:

1. Public Services and Procurement Canada received two questions in regards to the solicitation for which a public response was required. The questions and responses are provided below.

Question 1: In the tables found in the Basis of Payment, Item 1 (Travel - Lump sum price per round trip for travel time (non-productive labour), including all kilometer/mileage as follows). We do not know how many workers are required per trip. Can we assume two workers per trip and submit our pricing based on this assumption?

Response: Yes, this is an acceptable assumption. Please see the revised Basis of Payment tables (attached).

Question 2: Is the third party air sampling and air clearance (Item 3.c.) to include pricing for each location? The form only has one space to input one cost per day, so should we use the Prince Albert location, Willow Creek, or Saskatoon? As mileage cost will vary for each of the three locations, are we to just include one location cost, and if so which location, or do we write in/add in all three and include all three in the overall evaluation total?

Response: We have modified the Basis of Payment tables to include all three locations. Please see the attached tables.
