### B. Questions & Answers

**Q1** Can Parks Canada indicate on the Site Plan Mannix Pit the area that the contractor will be allowed to setup the Portable Asphalt Plant?

**A1** Refer to updated Mannix Pit Plan, "*H - Mannix Pit Plan November 2019\_Amendment 1 Markup.pdf*" in *DSP2\_19-0451.zip* folder.

**Q2** Is the Mannix pit locked? Would like to inspect on a site visit.

**A2** Mannix Pit is locked due to ongoing operations. Refer to updated Mannix Pit Plan, "*H - Mannix Pit Plan November 2019\_Amendment 1 Markup.pdf*" in *DSP2\_19-0451.zip* folder.

**Q3** Are any of the existing piles within the pit available for use by the contractor on this project?

**A3** No, refer to Contract Specifications Section 01 11 00 – 1.10

**Q4** Under 01 14 00 1.3.3.2 Camping – Where and what size is the anticipated location for camping?

**A4** Refer to Contract Specifications Section 01 14 00 – 1.3.3.2.1. The precise location and dimensions to be designated and confirmed by the Departmental Representative.

**Q5** Regarding the Concrete Barrier Re&Re works, what is considered an acceptable method for the cleanup of winter sand from shoulders? Can this simply be striking off the shoulder with a grader, and leaving the buildup on the shoulder?

**A5** In addition to Contract Specifications Section 33 71 13 – 1.2.2, all debris from cleaning of shoulders for barrier works is to be completely removed from site, hauled to and stockpiled in Mannix Pit at a location to be determined by the Departmental Representative. All costs associated with this work shall be considered incidental to *“Unit Price Item 5a – Precast Concrete Barrier – Remove, Stockpile and Reinstall Barrier”*.

**Q6** Can you provide the reasoning for postponing the start/completion segment 4 to the fall of 2020? If the contractor can complete all 4 segments prior to July 20, 2020, can the contractor do so without the additional mobilization? Is there a completion date that would allow for a single mobilization?

**A6** Refer to Contract Specifications Section 01 11 00 – 1.7.6 and 1.7.7.

Work is to adhere to the restrictions as described.
