#### C. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

**Q7 Will the trees that are cut down or already felled be removed from site or used as firewood for Parks Canada operations?**

A7 Everything is required to be removed from site, however; Parks does reserve the right to keep any materials they deem fit.

**Q8 If there is too much snow in an area or site for sufficient brushing to be completed would the contractor be able to return at a later date to complete the work?**

A8 In some circumstances this would be acceptable but if the work is after the breeding bird window opens a bird sweep would need to be conducted by Parks personnel before the brushing is continued. Extensions of Time will be considered on a case by case basis and will be subject to the approval of the project authority.

**Q9 Are the roofs to be worked on regardless of the amount of snow?**

A9 Yes, as long as Parks has not shut the work down.

**Q10 Will the avalanche closures along the Akamina Parkway affect the work to be conducted at the Little Prairie DUA?**

A10 Not likely, but there may be no-stopping measures placed for travel along the roadway.

**Q11 What type of equipment would Parks consider acceptable for the brushing work?**

A11 That is mainly up to the contractor to determine. If ground disturbance is to occur an archaeological assessment will be required. All of the information regarding this can be found in the WLNP BMP

**Q12 Can large woody debris be chipped and blown on-site?**

A12 No, chipped wood debris must be removed from site.

**Q13 Is smaller material brushed to be removed from site?**

A13 Yes, all brush must be removed from the site once cut.

**Q14 Can woody debris be burned on-site?**

A14 No, woody debris cannot be burned on-site. It must be removed.

**Q15 Is coarse/large woody debris already fallen also to be removed within the brushing contract?**

A15 Any woody debris within the brushing area must be removed from the site, even if it was previously fallen.

**Q16 Would any open holes that are created during a building removal have to be covered? Would the material to cover the hole(s) be provided by Parks?**

A16 Holes are required to be properly covered, the material required for this will not be provided by Parks.

**Q17 Will the sites along Hwy 5 remain open to the public during work as the contract said they would be?**

A17 These sites should likely be closed while the work is being completed; for public safety

**Q18 Would any stumps already existing within cutting areas need to be cut to the specs stated in the tender documents?**

A18 Yes, stumps within the brushing area are required to be cut-down to the height specified in the tender document.

**Q19 Would any trees that Parks chooses to keep be left on-site or where would they be taken?**

A19 Yes, the trees would be piled on-site for use by Parks at a later date.

**Q20 Who would hire the archaeologist in the case one is required?**

A20 Parks will provide an Archaeologist if one is required due to ground disturbance activities.

**Q21 Who is in charge of surveying the boundaries?**

A21 The contractor is in charge of surveying all boundaries.
