AMENDMENT 003

This amendment 003 is raised to:

- 1) Extending the registration deadline date for the Bidders' Conference, requests for Individual Meetings and Vessel Site Visit to Wednesday March 11, 2020, and
- 2) Answer questions from potential bidders.

1) Extending registration deadline date:

DELETE at Part 2, articles 2.7-Bidders' Conference, 2.8-Individual Meetings, and 2.9-Vessel Site Visit reference to registration deadline of March 6, 2020.

REPLACE registration deadline date with end of day Wednesday, March 11, 2020.

2) Questions and Answers:

- Q6: Please advise if the attendees to the Vessel site visit will need to bring their own Personal Protection Equipment (PPE), such as hard hats, work boots, etc, or will they be provided? If attendees are required to bring their own, what is the minimum PPE needed for the vessel site visit?
- A6: Canada will not supply any safety gear. Attendees are required to wear safety boots, pants and a long sleeve shirt as a minimum during the Site Visit.
- Q7: Please advise which security clearance(s) will be required to attend the Bidders Conference on March 24th in Halifax.
- A7: No, a security clearance is not required for the Bidders Conference or Vessel Site Visit on March 24th. The only requirement is an internal passport screening which will be completed following the submission of any passport as requested in Part 2, article 2.7 and article 2.9 of the RFP.
- Q8: It is not clearly identify which clearances are required in the instructions in Part 6 and Part 7 of the RFP documents, please clarify.
- A8: Part 6, article 6.1 describes when a bidder must have their security clearance. For this requirement a bidder is not required to have the necessary security clearance, as described in Part 7, in order to submit a bid but must have it in order to be awarded a contract. Part 7, article 7.3.1 and article 7.3.2 are the security requirements for a Canadian Supplier and Foreign Supplier respectively with the minimum requirement level set at Reliability clearance or foreign equivalency as described in 7.3.2 for the organization and personnel required on site.
- Q9: What documents are required to be completed and submitted, and to whom, in order to acquire the required clearance(s)?
- A9: For the documentation and assistance on completing the forms required to obtain a clearance, the Contract Security Program website address is located at Part 6, article 6.1.3 (www.tpsgc-pwgsc.gc.ca/esc-src/introduction-eng.html), information can also be found at www.tpsgc-pwgsc.gc.ca/esc-src/communiquer-contact-eng.html or call 1-866-368-4646.
