Further to the above-mentioned Invitation to Tender, this Addendum no.4 is to advise potential bidders of the following additional Question & Answer to this tender call to date:

Question 6: In reference to the Solicitation Mentioned in the Subject,

For M1 The bidder's proposed resource MUST have held /be eligible for /or have as a minimum a First Class Marine Engineering Certificate of Competency. A copy of this certificate must be provide by bid close date.

Would a competency from Royal Canadian navy as a Chief Engineer for her Majesty's Canadian Ships be acceptable? This includes all vessels inclusive of Destroyer, Frigate, Submarine, Tanker?

Answer 6: Marine Engineering used the First Class Engineering Certificate of Competency issued by Transport Canada as a standard to ensure that the level of expertise is what we require. Only Transport Canada can determine an equivalence to this certificate therefore if a perspective resource wishes to considered for this contract, that resource must provide a letter or other document from Transport Canada that states that the certificate which they hold is equivalent to a First Class Engineering Certificate of Competency issued by Transport Canada.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
