Key pain areas	A2. Key functional elements, technical elements and pain areas will be defined at the RFP stage. However a key feature that is desired is for staff to be able to pose science and technology-related questions internally within the department for other staff to respond AND to have the ability to later expand to other Federal Government Departments as the opportunity arises.
Q3. Q15 of the RFI asks about data storage and suggests it may be a requirement to host within Canada. Can you confirm if this is a hard requirement or a desire?	A3. The requirements to store and protect the information will be defined at the RFP stage. However, Canada would like to examine the industry's ability to store and protect GC information at the Protected B level.
