#### QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

##### **Q1. What is the organic waste composition?**

**Is the organic waste composition limited to only human food waste excluding other organic human wastes such as wastewater treatment residuals?**

A1. As stated in the Problem statement of the challenge, *“GAC is looking for a solution to treat the waste that it produces, that is neither compostable nor recyclable, with the objective of lowering its emissions and reducing what is sent to landfills. “*
