## **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

## Q1. What is the organic waste composition?

Is the organic waste composition limited to only human food waste excluding other organic human wastes such as wastewater treatment residuals?

A1. As stated in the Problem statement of the challenge, "GAC is looking for a solution to treat the waste that it produces, that is neither compostable nor recyclable, with the objective of lowering its emissions and reducing what is sent to landfills."
