Questions	Responses:
<p>Is the successful candidate required to have engineers registered in all jurisdictions in which the projects being assessed take place?</p>	<p>The primary resource proposed by the Bidder must have P.Eng designation in at least one jurisdiction.</p>
<p>The Mandatory Requirements M2 requires proposed resources to have a P.Eng Certification. However, the Scope of Work Section in Annex A indicates, "Personnel required would be from a variety of skill and expertise levels, ranging from Engineers-In-Training to senior specialists or experts".</p> <p>Please provide further clarification and confirm the requirements of the desired resources (i.e. – EIT's, P.Eng, Sr. Eng, etc)?</p>	<p>Primary resource must have P.Eng designation. While the work could be conducted by other resources, this has to be done under the supervision of the primary resource who is ultimately responsible for the quality and accuracy of work.</p>
<p>The Solicitation Number on the title page for the Proposal for Engineering Services due June 1, 2020 is 84084-20-0013, however the information provided in Section 2.2 Submission of Bids (shown below), indicates a different Bid Solicitation Number 84084-19-0109.</p> <p>Would you please confirm if this is correct, or whether the Bid Solicitation Number shown on the title page should be used with the return Proposal?</p>	<p>Section <b>2.2 Submission of Bids</b> should read as follows:</p> <p>Bids must be submitted electronically by email only to <a href="mailto:proposals.propositions@cer-rec.gc.ca">proposals.propositions@cer-rec.gc.ca</a> by the date, time and place indicated on page 1 of the bid solicitation.</p> <p>The subject line should specify the Bid Solicitation Number: 84084-20-0013.
