This Amendment is raised to respond to questions related to this Request for Information.

Question 10:	The request is to submit a response to this standing offer, however it does not warrants that it will be utilized should a requirement arise in the near future, correct?
Response 10:	This is a Request for Information (RFI) and not a Request for Standing Offer. We are seeking feedback at this time however, Public Services and Procurement Canada (PSPC) cannot warrant that specific suggestions received will be used.
Question 11:	If there is no guarantee that it will proceed then why go through the entire process of submission and utilizing time and effort?
Response 11:	As mentioned above, this is a Request for Information. Engaging industry is essential and the feedback received is valuable when it comes to developing a new procurement strategy. Responses to the following questions in Appendix A will assist the department in assessing the merits and practicality of developing and utilizing this integrated approach for project delivery for fit-up projects.
Question 12:	Will there be another round of submission once this process is complete?
Response 12:	This is to be determined. PSPC may choose to do additional consultation depending on the number and content of responses received, such as to seek clarifications on the feedback received.
Question 13:	Assuming once the list is formed, will PSPC only work with those vendors until the end of the standing offer or will you be still posting projects open to public?
Response 13:	This potential design-build standing offer for office fit-up projects would be one of several procurement methodologies used to deliver projects. The procurement methodology for each project will be decided on a case-by-case basis based on the needs of the project and the merits of the procurement methodologies.
Question 14:	How will this standing offer impact where PSPC is leasing from private landlords?
Response 14:	The proposed design-build standing offer for fit-up is intended for use in crown-owned assets. PSPC will continue to work with their landlords to complete fit-up in leased buildings.
Question 15:	How many vendors will be added to the list?
Response 15:	This is to be determined and may depend on a number of factors including government business volumes as well as industry capacity.
Question 16:	In reviewing the above noted RFI it would be helpful to have some clarification regarding the bid process for such a joint venture project. Under this Design Build Standing Offer arrangement, would furniture manufacturers and/or dealers be required to adhere to the current Supply Arrangements already in place for these commodities or would a DBSO supersede the "Workspaces SA" procurement

guidelines? It is unclear whether the intent is to award all services to such a joint venture or consortium prior to building design. Would this then be expected to be included in a “per square metre” pricing quotation and if so, what variance would be allowed based on the client’s choices of layout, workpoint styles and floorplate layouts?

This potential design-build standing offer for fit-up would be one of several procurement methodologies used to deliver projects. These methodologies are expected to continue to include Supply Arrangements for furniture.
