This revision is to answer the following question:

Question 2:

We would like to kindly ask you to consider following request: With reference to Annex B, item 3.1.6: The added requirement of the display (to comply with item 3.3.4.5) and the GPS (to comply with item 3.3.4.4) makes it very difficult to use a small model to comply with the weight that would also comply with the requirement of autonomy.

1. The requirement 3.3.4.4 is "The SCOLL must have the functionality to automatically switch into "OFF" mode at a user-configurable, preprogramed date, and automatically turn on again at a later, user-configurable, preprogramed date" this requirement does not ask for a manual switch and in order to comply with this requirement we need to add a GPS to the lanterns to receive the exact date and hour continuously and this will increase the consumption. Please clarify if the purpose of this requirement is something else.

2. The requirement 3.3.4.5 is "A direct form of clear and concise visual feedback must be provided of lantern settings (e.g.: a digital display)." This requirement is clearly asking for a display to be supplied with each lantern and this will also increase the consumption. Please clarify if the purpose of this requirement is something else.

3. The added consumption of GPS and display will need a more powerful and heavier battery for some lantern categories and for some categories more powerful lanterns. This increases the weight and for some categories dimension of the lanterns. Since we need to comply with above requirements and also the requested autonomy we need to offer more powerful and heavier lanterns. Please note that with the requested changes there is not much difference for the manipulation of the lanterns. Would you please accept following changes to the weight and dimension requirements?

We reflected the requested changes in red color.

Answer 2:

1. The vendor must find its way to add the functionality in the lantern. CCG does not ask the vendor to switch the lantern Off/On remotely, but at a preprogramed date (for example, a calendar program can be added in the lantern program to shut off automatically the lantern every December 31st and then turn on every March 15th. GPS is not necessarily required to add the new functionality.

2. A "direct form of clear and concise visual feedback" does not mean necessarily that it has to be located on the lantern itself. For example, the vendor could use a PDA (personal digital assistant) equipped with a screen in which you can program the lantern.

3. No, CCG will not change the requirements of weight nor dimension of the Table 1 (Annex B).
