Answer 1: The bid must be based in accordance with Annex B, Basis of payments Tables 1 to 4.

- 1. personal certification
- 2. Vessel certification

Answer 2: Transport Canada requires that all buoy contractors have personal and vessel certification. The certification can vary depending on the tasks the contractor is required to do and on the size of buoys and anchors that are to be serviced. To learn about which certifications are required please contact your local Transport Canada office.

Question 3: The tenderer is responsible for storage – how much are the buoys and other items worth?

Answer 3: The actual value of the buoys and other items related to a contract will vary depending on numerous factors. Number, size, type of buoy, chain size and amount, anchor size. It can amount to several thousands of dollars for even a small contract.
