Q1. It does not look as though the exterior orange paint was sampled for lead content as part of the original hazardous waste survey. If the lead content exceeds criteria, extra costs for removal and/or disposal may be incurred. Do you want us to proceed with the paint sampling at the beginning of the project?"

A1. Bidders should be prepared to undertake the sampling of the building's exterior paint at the start of the fieldwork stage, cost of sampling should be included in the bid. Extra costs incurred for the disposal of the exterior panels, should they contain hazardous amounts of lead, will be handled with a change order.
