If only one of the organizations has DSC; it will be indicated on the contract that the work can only be performed at a specific address where the DSC is approved."</p> <p>In response to this Response, please address the following: Can the successful proponent, who submitted with a Joint Venture name (a non-legal entity), sign the contract with this name but reference both organizations who have legal entities that meet the DSC security requirements?</p>

Cleaning services are considered the same as other sub-contracted works. 2) Total project duration is 42 months. Construction cannot be assumed to follow design linearly using Annex C 1.3.3 as construction can start before all design packages are completed. Both design and total project duration can take less time than the maximum amounts indicated in Annex C 1.3.3.

It clearly states on page 4 and other places, that, "fundamentally this is a service contract". In the RFP it is asks for the 4 IBP criteria (training, labour, goods and services by Indigenous Firms (including subcontracting) and other benefits).</p> <p>Beyond hours and total dollars, we are directed to include specific positions as well as specific community businesses that will be confirmed by the 5 FN's that can fulfil scope, while not knowing the full scope of the project and only pricing for CM services only. This is confusing and I am not sure what exactly we should be providing. Is it an IBP on a project we do not have full scope on or do we provide an IBP solely on the CM services portion focused on the primary 6 positions and any additional minor services as listed in the RFQ?</p>
A4	<p><i>An IBP is intended to develop capacity, sustainable and meaningful socio-economic benefits for Indigenous professionals and businesses for various specialized professions covered under this project.</i></p> <p><i>The IBP is to cover all work completed during construction. For the Sidney project the Schematic Design along with the elemental Class C estimate contained within can assist for in determining the scope of work.</i></p>
