QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Question 7: Regarding Work Stream 1 through to Work Stream 4, along with each of the respective categories within each of those streams tied to MTC1, MTC1-B, and RTC1:

The requirement for MTC1-A, MTC1-B and RTC1 states that the Crown is looking for all of these billable days to come from one single resource. Would the Crown please confirm that multiple resources under cited Contract(s) are able to be used to meet the billable day requirements for respective categories?

Answer 7: The billable days requirements for MTC1-A, MTC1-B, and RTC1 for all workstreams are as follows:

- a) MTC1-A: the Bidder must demonstrate that it has provided services that are the same or similar to the resource categories specified in the criterion for each workstream, in which the single resource has a minimum of 120 billable days for a period of one year. The minimum 120 billable days for a single resource category may be demonstrated by multiple individuals, but must not have been acquired concurrently. As indicated in the criterion, in situations where a resource was replaced, the Bidder must include the names of the replacement resources and the start and end dates of each resource. See Solicitation Revision 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 and 12.
- b) MTC1-B: The 2,000 billable days is for all of the resource categories in the referenced contracts including the two resource categories specified in the criterion for each workstream covering a period not more than three years.

The work required of most PIA Specialist's is short term; not more than a few months at a time. Given we can only submit one resource for this category, can the Crown please consider allowing multiple resources to meet this requirement or consider reducing the number of billable days required to score maximum points for RTC1 for the PIA Specialist.

Answer 9: The criterion has been revised. Please see Solicitation Revision 11.
