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AMENDMENT 004

Amendment 004 is raised to:

1. Provide answers to questions received with regards to this Request for Proposal (RFP); et
2. Amend Attachment 1 to Part 4, Technical and Financial Criteria.

Note: Questions may have been modified and/or condensed.

Questions and Answers

Q26: Please confirm that the nurse references to be provided for each Stream are not meant those nurses are committed for this role. Rather, the references demonstrate the company's ability to supply nurses with this expertise.

A26: The nurse references do not need to be the nurses that are committed for this role. The references are to validate the company's capability to provide a minimum number of required nurses per day (depending on the stream) at a minimum of 14 consecutive days.

Q27: The MTC1 requirement in all streams ask that the nurses listed must have performed similar nursing services at least 5 times in the last 2 years from the date of this solicitation. Is there a set number of days that is acceptable to fulfill this requirement without it being at least 5 times. Please clarify what is the ruling if a nurse has worked continuously in one location for 2 years? Please confirm in this case that one reference is enough.

A27: MTC1 has been modified, see C4 in the section Changes below. To clarify, client references are being sought for the contracts, not for individual nurses. If a nurse has continuously worked in one location (in 1 contract) for 2 years, the nurse would be named as one of the required nurses provided under a contract depending on the stream. The Bidder must have experience of at least 5 contracts providing nursing services; therefore, a reference (i.e. name of the client and contact information) is required for each of the at least 5 contracts.

Please note that:

- Each contract duration must have been for at a minimum of 14 consecutive days (while maintaining a minimum of number of required RNs per day, depending on the stream), and have been within the last two years from the date of this solicitation.
- The RNs in each contract did not have to work consecutive days; therefore, different RNs could have been provided while maintaining a minimum of number of required RNs per day, depending on the stream.

Q28: In ATTACHMENT 1 TO PART 4 - TECHNICAL AND FINANCIAL CRITERIA, It states the following as a qualification to respond:

"MTC1 - Corporate Experience

The Bidder must have provided a minimum of 2 Registered Nurses (RNs) to perform nursing services similar to those described in the Statement of Work at least 5 times in the last 2 years from the date of this solicitation.

The nursing services must have taken place in the same province or territory for the stream for which the Bidder is bidding, and must have been for a minimum of 14 continuous calendar days.

The RNs must have had to conduct health assessments using personal protective equipment in an environment requiring infection control procedures in the province or territory for the stream in which the Bidder is bidding.”

Given that the use of recruiting services for Nursing is not very common, the listed requirements of 2 nurses, 5 times in the last two years will reduce competition for this opportunity. Would Canada accept 1 experience in the last 5 years as acceptable as long as 2 resources meeting the requirements are provided in the response?

A28: The number of references is still required but MTC1 has been modified, please see C4 in the section Changes below.

Q29: Per section 4.1.1.2 Client Reference Checks: May you kindly confirm the number of references you require per stream when the bidder is only submitting a bid for one (1) stream being stream six (6).

A29: The number of references required depends on the mandatory criteria to be demonstrated in each particular stream. Both MTC1 and MTC 2 have been modified please see C4 in the section Changes below.

Q30: Per section 4.1.1.2 Client Reference Checks: We currently hold a number of long standing multi nurse contracts. Can you please confirm that the names of nurses providing/have provided services are not required as part of each individual client reference submitted.

A30: The names of the nurses included as part of each individual contract must be provided.

Q31: Per Attachment 1 To Part 4, Technical and Financial Criteria, 2. Mandatory Technical Criteria (MTC), MTC2 - Corporate Experience Providing Nursing Resources on a Standby Basis: Would Canada consider a separate hourly rate for standby resources.

A31: There is a rate description at Annex B, 1.1 Regular and Stand-by hourly rates: Stand-by is payable at the rate of one hour of the Regular Hourly Rate for every eight hours of Stand-by.

Q32: Appendix B to Annex A outlines the estimated hours of coverage required at the Quarantine Sites across Canada. Can PHAC please confirm that scheduling for that shift coverage is at the Bidder's discretion, or does PHAC require that the same nurse work the full shift?

A32: The same nurse must work the full shift.

Q33: Can PHAC please clarify the number of references that the bidder needs to provide? The below response, as outlined in amendment 2, states that the Bidder must provide 5 references, however in Attachment 1 to Part 4 Technical and Financial Criteria, Section 1 Evaluation Experience, states in the second bullet that “Experience can be demonstrated using one or more contracts of services rendered”. We are confused by the terminology of 5 times, so would PHAC please clarify that “perform nursing services similar to those described in the Statement of Work at least 5 times in the last 2 years from the date of this solicitation” means that the Nurses provided services 5 times within the one Contract (as stated in the evaluation criteria), and not that 5 contracts are required to be demonstrated?

A33: MTC1 and MTC 2 have been modified see C4 in the section Changes below. To clarify, client references are being sought for the contracts, not for individual nurses. The Bidder must have experience of at least 5 contracts providing nursing services; therefore, a reference (i.e. name of the client and contact information) is required for each of the at least 5 contracts.

Please note that:

- Each contract duration must have been for at a minimum of 14 consecutive days (while maintaining a minimum of number of required RNs per day, depending on the stream), and have been within the last two years from the date of this solicitation.
- The RNs in each contract did not have to work consecutive days; therefore, different RNs could have been provided while maintaining a minimum of number of required RNs per day, depending on the stream.

TECHNICAL AND FINANCIAL CRITERIA

1. Evaluation of Experience

The following applies to the evaluation of mandatory criteria:

- Experience listed should include the day, month and year for both the start and finish dates. If the day is not provided, it will be evaluated as the last day of the month, in the case of the start date, and the first day of the month, in the case of the finish date. If the month or year are not provided, the experience will not be considered.

2. Mandatory Technical Criteria (MTC)
