4.2 Basis of Selection

A bid must comply with all requirements of the bid solicitation to be declared responsive. The responsive bid with the lowest evaluated price per location(s) will be recommended for award of a contract.

Canada reserves the right to award multiple contracts resulting from this RFP. No more than one contract will be issued per location. Contractors could be issued a contract for provision of services for one or multiple locations. Each location will be evaluated individually

Also refer to Annex B - Revised Newfoundland Basis of Payment - 2020 (EN).

Payment will be made for costs reasonably and properly incurred in the performance of the work, in accordance with the contractor's cost proposal and the Statement of Work.

Offerors can bid on this project in whole or in part (by choosing one (1) or multiple locations). By choosing a location, the bidder agrees to cover the entire area pertaining to the location. (e.g. All buoy locations under Annapolis).

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
