Questions and Responses – Amendment 002

Q) Ab 02-022 Brooks: There are 25 uprights to replace. Are these in solo foundations or do these get chopped out of a concrete sidewalk?

R) These are individual “boot” exposed foundations as defined on Pages 39-40 of the RFP (Sect. 4.4 of the Tech Manual). A visual of this can be found on pages 43-45 of the RFP. Text of marker will be supplied, proof of marker must be approved prior to production, installed as per RFP and old marker destroyed, old foundation removed, greenery restored.

Q) Ab 06-002 Burnsland in Cowtown: 24 new foundations. Same question really, are these solo foundations? Like a concrete boot or the CWGC style? In the same cemetery, the 2 upright replacements are just concrete boots/CWGC foundations, yeah?

R) There is a continuous beam on grade (visible & flush with grass) as defined on Pages 39-40 of the RFP (Sect. 4.4 of the Tech Manual). A visual of this can be found on pages 50-52 of the RFP. The existing concrete “sidewalk” beam encases the existing markers. The concrete will need to be cut, markers removed, framing created to line up with the remaining beam on either side, new concrete poured, existing marker set and aligned in the newly poured beam, the remaining old foundation removed, and greenery restored. A physical site visit or internet search for images of Burnsland will demonstrate the work required.

Q) Ab06-004 Queen's Park in Calgary, Ab: The bid's asking for a bunch of new flat foundations. What does that mean? I remember there are entire sections of Queen's Park that are flat monuments, but they're FLAT-flat, like flush with the ground so they can be mowed over. What kind of work needs to happen here? Some flat monuments get a concrete border around the flat headstone, some get granite or concrete foundations under the monument, but I'm not clear what the desired end product looks like here.

R) These are individual flat marker foundations (not on a “beam”) as described on Pages 39-40 of the RFP (Sect. 4.4 of the Tech Manual). A visual of this can be found on pages 46-47 of the RFP. The top of the flat marker will sit flush with grass and supported by a foundation as per RFP. New materials may be needed for the foundation, old materials will need to be removed, greenery restored.

All Other Terms and Conditions Remain the Same.
