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**This amendment is raised to respond to the questions received from the industry and to provide a new version of Annex B - Specification and Annex D -Evaluation Criteria for Pre-Award Sample**

Question no 8:

ANNEX "B" SPECIFICIATION, Item no. 6.

- a. Please confirm the dimensions, shape, and weight of "two 30 round 5.56 calibre carbine magazines".
- b. Please confirm the dimensions, shape, and weight of the "multi-tool size tool" that must fit in each thigh pocket.
- c. Please confirm that "Velcro" (a specific proprietary product) is required or whether the requirement is "Hook & Loop material (example: Velcro)".

Answer No 8:

- a. the magazine weighs approximately 1.5 lbs and has the dimensions of approximately 3.25" x 7.5" x 1".
- b. There is no specified size for the multi-tool, it will need to fit a standard multi-tool brand i.e. Leatherman, Gerber, SOG, etc.
- c. Hook & Loop material is acceptable.

Question no 9

ANNEX "B" SPECIFICIATION, Item no. 7.

Clarification is requested for the "back knee tabs". Are these tabs intended for use with the knee pads that are in the suit or with external knee pads?

Answer No 9:

These tabs are intended to accommodate varying user sizes by allowing the user to quickly affix the knee portion of the leg of the suit in a position so as the internal knee pad remains in the proper position.

Question no 10

ANNEX "B" SPECIFICIATION, Item no. 10. Clarification is requested for "protection for socks". Are these intended to fit over the socks attached to the suit?

Answer No 10:

Criteria has been removed from the requirement and solicitation amended accordingly. Please see solicitation amendment below for full details.

No additional protective sock is required. Protection refers to reinforcement of the sock portion of the suit as it is a high wear area when the suit is donned and doffed prior to the user putting on footwear. This would be at the supplier's discretion as to the durability of the sock material.

Question no 11

ANNEX "B" SPECIFICATION, Additional Requirements: 2) Repair Kit. Confirmation is requested that patches must be "of the same material that the dry suit is made of". Is this still required if suit patching is done from the inside of the suit and/or knowing that breathable material becomes non-breathable as soon as glue or adhesive is applied.

Answer No 11:

The repair kit requirement stands as posted.

Question no 12

ANNEX "B" SPECIFICATION, Item No. 11. Clarification is requested for "gun belts and harnesses". Please would you provide details/dimensions/photos of the relevant belts and harnesses?

Answer No 12:

Gun belts and harnesses vary and will not attach directly to the suit. The suit is to have a minimum of two horizontal loops to attach belt keepers.

**B.1.Tactical Operation Dry suit (TODS):**

To ensure that each candidate is properly protected in accordance with the Canada Labour Code the TODS must have the following minimum specifications:

Item No.	Specification
1	The TODS shell must be made of a waterproof and breathable dry suit fabric (example: Gore-tex) with reinforcement of a ballistic nylon which must have incorporated into it drainage that will prevent water becoming trapped in those areas.
2	The neck of the TODS must come with an adjustable neck seal which does not involve any material overlap. The user must be able to easily and quickly vent the suit with one hand (left or right)
3	The wrists of the TODS must be made of neoprene or latex.
4	<p>The TODS must be repairable in theater or garrison with the supplied repair kit and cannot include a requirement for the user to carry additional tools.</p> <p>These field repairs include minor holes or tears that could arise from catching a sharp edge during operations. The repair procedure will render the suit fully operable in less than one hour. Each suit must come complete with a repair kit when it is shipped.</p>
5	<p>Refer to Amendment 002:</p> <p>The TODS must have a zipper system for entry and relief that is low profile, lightweight and corrosion resistant which is easy to operate (open and close) by one person. It must be in a location which provides comfort and no pressure spots to the user when wearing other equipment (ie personal flotation devices, rappel harness, etc).</p>

11	The TODS waist band must have Velcro waist adjustments with a minimum of two horizontal loops for removable belt keepers to help hold gun belts and harnesses in place.
12	The TODS overcuffs must be made of ballistic nylon that will reinforce the wrists and ankles as well as velcro closures for adjustability by the user.
13	The TODS must be subdued (not harsh or bright) in colour. Examples of acceptable colours are "ranger green", olive drab green, tan, blue-grey, greys or any combinations thereof or similarly coloured disruptive patterns. Examples of colours not accepted are yellow, red, orange, or black.
14	<p>Bidder Qualifications:</p> <p>The Dry Suit Manufacturer must have been in the business of developing, manufacturing and supplying Tactical Operation Dry suits (TODS) for a minimum of five (5) years.</p>

## **Additional Requirements:**

### **2) Repair Kit**

Each Tactical Operations Dry Suit (TODS) must come with one repair kit.

Repair kit must at minimum consist of the following:

- A) Patches (4) which are of the same material that the dry suit is made of size of patch 37mm x 50 mm.
- B) Applicable amount of fast acting Glue or fast acting adhesive which will allow the user to use on the four patches and the glue must dry in one (1) hour or less so that the end user can return to operations if required. The container of glue must have a lid or be capable of being sealed again for future use.
- C) Repair kit must contain quick instructions in English, or when available, bilingual French/English on how to complete the repair using the materials contained within the kit and any warnings about the contents of the repair kit.
- D) Repair kit must come in a bag or small container which can be easily stored in one of the pockets or carried by the individual in their personal kit bag. The container or bag must be labeled "REPAIR KIT FOR".

### **3) Operating and Care Instruction Manual**

Offeror must provide the English, or when available, bilingual French/English, operating and care instructions with each suit.
