To all bidders,

NO consideration will be given for extras and/or changes because the Bidder was not familiar with the contents of this Amendment.

This amendment 002 is raised to :

- 1) Answer questions from bidders;
- 2) Modify Annex A- Requirement and Basis of Selection.

1) Questions & Answers

Question 3: Regarding the non-SA "movable walls - Quiet Area" can you confirm that it is a quantity of one (1)? Under the Quantity column it reads "21 meter Li."

Answer 3: This item has been deleted. Please refer to revised Annex A- Requirement and Basis of Selection (see pages 4 to 21 below).

Question 4: Item 1 – Your asking for 3 Privacy Screens 54" length, but there is no surface required of this size. Do they go with Item 4 - Category 2?

Answer 4: This item will be associated with item 5 category 2. The panel is shorter than the surface.

Question 5: Item 2 - GOCUID is for a quantity of 7 surfaces of 29 x 72 that hook onto panels ... but there are no panels in the order. Can you specify your need?

Answer 5: We already have the panels and the C-legs that matches our panel system. We only need the surfaces.

Question 6 : Item 10 - Can you specify the required height of removable walls as well as the height of the ceiling?

Answer 6 : Item 10 has been deleted.

Question 7: Item 12 - you are requesting 38 double lockers (therefore 2 doors high), maximum total height of 54 ". Would an 18 "wide x 20" deep x 25 "high (approximately) product be acceptable?

Answer 7: That is acceptable, as long as the maximum height of 54" is observed.

Question 8: In your plan, only 20 lockers are identified. Could you clarify?

Answer 8: We ordered extra lockers. Please refer to the quantities listed in the order and not in the floor plan as part of this RFB.

Question 9: Item 23 - I do not see this item (curved chair) in the plan. Could you clarify?

Answer 9: Please make sure you refer to the quantity indicated in the order and not in the floor plan when bidding.

Question 10: Item 32 - I don't see this item in the plan? Could you clarify?

Answer 10: Please make sure you refer to the quantity indicated in the order and not in the floor plan when bidding.

Question 11 : After reviewing the CAD document, would it be possible for the items to be identified on the plan to ensure that the specified products match?

Answer 11 : This has been added to the CAD version.

Question 12: We request that Category 6 be split into Sub-Categories as divided in the CST/product type - 1) Meeting and Collaborative Tables, 2) Soft Seating/Screens, 3) Kitchenette Seating and 4) Open Area Workspaces.

Answer 12: For compatibility reasons, we will not subdivide this category.

Question 13: Item 23 - SA criteria requires back rest to be no less than 8.5 inches from seat top. Product can qualify on SA but not meet non SA criteria for Item #33. Based on this can this item be split off the rest of Cat 6 as it incorporates a Non SA item as part of its criteria?

Answer 13: Item 33 is no longer connected to item 23 but with item 26. It won't be a curvilinear tablet it will be linear. See Annex A below (pages 4 to 21).

Question 14: Item 30 - Request is for Bent Plywood, 4 legs (GoCUID KSBHxxLP15XXXROYX) - Would either GoCUID 6KSBHxxSP15XXXRONX (Bent Plywood, no seat, with Sled Base) or GoCUID 6KSBHxxLY15XXXROYX (Polymer, seat, with 4 legs) be acceptable as an alternate?

Answer 14: Yes.

Question 15: Items 34 & 35 - these products are manufacturer specific and have no equivalent with other manufacturers - can they be split off from this category?

Answer 15: Items 34 and 35 have been deleted. See Annex A below (pages 4 to 21).

Design Upgrade Rule:

The IU may exercise an option to upgrade products up to 20% of each Category product total before Applicable Taxes after contract award.

The Design Upgrade amount is used at the discretion of the Project Authority (PA) **prior to the manufacturing/ordering of the products**, the PA will provide the Contractor with a written notice of Canada's Design Upgrade choices for each of the product(s) to be upgraded. The Contractor will provide the pricing of the upgraded product(s) to a maximum of 20% of each Category Contract Price of Table 8. The Contracting Authority will issue an amendment to the contract with the Design Upgrades and pricing.

The Supplier certifies that all the Design Upgraded products offered will conform to all specifications and meet the testing requirements detailed in the Specifications of the Supply Arrangement.

Design Upgrade: is the process of replacing a product with a more innovative or enhanced version of the same product.

NSA:

NSA products can be incorporated in the RFB and must not exceed 30% of the firm quantity by category. NSA items must be added to the category that is most closely related and must be generic.

The requirement includes the following category (ies) of work :

a. Category 1 – Interconnecting Panels and Freestanding Systems

RULE: Metal Storage
