This amendment is raised to:

A. Answer bidder's questions.

A. Questions and Answers

- Q1. The specification indicates both 1:2:6 and 1:2:9 mortar mixes with the acceptable manufactures being Daubois and King to be used for this project. It also indicates that for the work up to 1m above the ground level there is to be the addition of latex added to the mortar. In our experience Latex would not be added to a historical repoint project and would also cause a large variation in the mortars properties. In addition the 3 variations of mortar will not have the same colour tone when cured and will have a visually different appearance. Is this how we are to proceed with pricing this project or will we be using a unified historical mortar throughout the repointing work to have a uniform appearance, also there will be no warranty from Daubois if Latex is added to their product.
- **A1.** We will be using one historical mortar throughout the repointing work for a unified appearance. The mortar formula should be simple and preferably without additives. The colours should be achieved with the sand colours from the local sources that possibly was used for the original mortar mix. We will use mock ups to determine the best colour and mix.
- Q2. The specification section 01 11 00 1.9.2 and 01 45 00 1.3.1 indicates that all cost of testing will be borne by the PCA representative, however in section 04 03 05 1.6.10 (period masonry Repointing) it indicates that the testing cost will be borne by the contractor.
- A2. Costs for testing will be by the contractor.
- Q3. Will we have to maintain public access through the front entry during the project.
- **A3.** The public will not be visiting the church.
- Q4. It is indicated in section 01 11 00 1.4.2 that the hours of noise and vibration causing work will only be conducted between 10:00 to 15:00 hours Monday to Friday. Please note that this will act to increase the schedule over a typical 8 to 10 hour work day and push the schedule further into a period of inclement weather that will create more costs for maintaining the site and accommodating the weather conditions, are these hours of work to be enforced?
- A4. The work day can be 8:00AM 8:00PM
