1) Questions & Answers

Question 16: In reference to the above note bid solicitation, would the crown be willing to remove the PSAB designation for CAT 6 only and retender as General Stream. The PSAB designation for CAT 6 is abnormal and by going to General Stream, would allow for more bidders and better value to the crown.

Answer 16: The products from Category 6 have been deleted. Please refer to revised Annex A- Requirement and Basis of Selection (see pages 4 to 21 below).
