As we were in a position to submit a complete bid, including Category 6, we ask that when it is re-issued that it be available under both General Stream and PSAB, to allow us to compete in this solicitation.

Answer 17: Items from Category 6 have been reinstated in this solicitation. Please refer to Annex A below.

Question 18: Will you be issuing a CAT 6 only tender?

Answer 18: CSPS has decided that this solicitation will be set aside for Aboriginal businesses, including Category 6 items. However, if no compliant bids are received following this solicitation, it will be re-tendered under the "general" stream.
