This amendment is raised to provide responses to bidder questions.

A. Questions and Answers

- Q1.** The professional designation is to be someone with a vegetation specialty/focus?
- A1.** Yes. The P.Biol or PAg referenced in Evaluation Criteria 2.4 must be registered in AB and practice the profession in a manner that is relatable to the scope of services defined for this project.
- Q2.** Is the person referenced in Q1 required to be on-site at all times?
- A2.** No. The level of engagement of the P.Biol or PAg must be outlined and will be assessed as part of the technical evaluation as referenced in Evaluation Criteria 2.5.
- Q3.** Is there an opportunity to harvest seed only from rare plants outside of the hatched area, while leaving the vegetation?
- A3.** Yes. Salvage of plants is restricted to within the limits of disturbance as shown on the provided plans. However, harvest of seed may occur anywhere in the Park. Seed harvest outside the campground must be recorded by GPS and follow best practices for rare plant collection as per Alberta Native Plant Council Guidelines.
- Q4.** Due to the timing of project start is there an option to conduct a portion of the harvest next year when plants are more easily visible/ in seed?
- A4.** There may be opportunity to harvest in Spring 2021. However, the bidder should not rely on this schedule as the reconstruction contractor will have control of the site for the entirety of 2021. The rare plant salvage contractor shall make every effort to complete the salvage work in 2020.
