Q1: Will the vessels be subjected to salt-water conditions?

A1: Yes, the vessel will operate in salt water.

Q2: Please clarify whether the vessels must be new?

A2: Yes, the vessels must be new.

Q3: In the event used vessels are acceptable must they be identical models and in the interests of fairness how will Canada compare the evaluated price of a used vessel against a new vessel?

A3: The vessels must be new as indicated in the statement of requirement

Q4: Please confirm weight capacity (payload) means weight capacity of people + fuel + cargo?

A4: That is correct.

Q5: Please confirm the weight capacity (payload) must be based on the ability for the vessel to start from a stopped position in deep water?

A5: That is correct.

Q6: Is the trailer required to be road legal? If so please confirm the trailer must meet CMVSS standards?

A6: Yes, the trailer must be road legal and must meet CMVSS standards.

Q7: Is the dimension of the trailer required to be operated on Canadian roads without any requirement to obtain permits?

A7: That is correct.

Q8: Please specify the type or class of tow vehicle.

A8: Heavy duty Pick-up truck.

Q9: Please confirm that vessels must meet Transport Canada standard TP1332?
