This second (002) solicitation amendment is raised to answer questions from the Industry.

Q24: We are trying to understand whether or not our bid would be considered nonresponsive if it does not include convenience cheques. I do not see the convenience cheques specifically listed under the Mandatory Technical Criteria nor under the Points Rated Technical Criteria (PRTC) which has prompted this inquiry. Further, if convenience cheques are a component that will be scored under the PRTC, may I kindly request clarification as to which criteria it will be considered under.

A24: Providing convenience cheques is not mandatory, but highly recommended.

Q25: Can the contract (Sales Volume rebate Section 1.1) be amended in the event of a change in economics? Specifically if government legislation were to be passed that minimized the merchant discount fees or lowered the revenue generated from corporate card interchange, would there be an opportunity to amend the financial component of the contract to adjust for the impact on the change?

A25: 7.6.2 Opportunity for Financial Component Adjustment (Rebates Only)

The Contractor must advise the Contracting Authority by written notice, should the Contractor determine that a change in applicable laws or regulations made after the award of the Contract affects the credit card interchange rates, so that it makes it unlawful, impractical or impossible for the Contractor to continue to maintain the agreed upon rebates. If Canada agrees with the justifications provided by the Contractor in the notice, the Contracting Authority will offer to negotiate in good faith an acceptable modification to the rebates. The parties will have thirty calendar days from the date the Contracting Authority offered to negotiate to come to a resolution. This thirty-day period could be extended up to a maximum of another thirty 30 calendar days, at Canada's sole discretion. Should both parties fail to come to an agreement within that period, then the Contract would be terminated by mutual consent.
