1. I was looking into the bid that is closing tomorrow, regarding the face masks for arriving travelers and I noticed that security clearance is required. How would I go about finding a sponsor that could authorize the clearance for me?

Please also note that the solicitation closing period has been changed to August 24th, 2020 as per the update on August 19th, 2020.
