Part 1, General Information

Article 1.2 Summary

Add

1.2.6 This RFSO allows offerors to use the epost Connect service provided by Canada Post Corporation to transmit their offers electronically. Offerors must refer to Part 2 of the RFSO entitled Offeror Instructions and Part 3 of the RFSO entitled Offer Preparation Instructions, for further information on using this method.

Article 1.2.1 (1.2.1.3) Requirement

Delete: There are 2 separate zones and separate pricing for each zone must be provided.

Insert: **There are 2 separate zones and separate pricing for each zone must be provided.**

Bidder can bid either or both zones. The two zones are as follows:

Zone 1. Okanagan Area including Kamloops, Kelowna and Vernon

Zone 2: Lower Mainland including Chilliwack River Valley and other locations

Detailed locations listed under Annex C, Delivery Point and Contact information.

PART 2 - OFFEROR INSTRUCTIONS

Add

Article 2.6 Bid Challenge and Recourse Mechanisms

2.6.1 Several mechanisms are available to potential offerors to challenge aspects of the procurement process up to and including contract award.

2.6.2 Canada encourages offerors to first bring their concerns to the attention of the Contracting Authority. Canada's Buy and Sell website, under the heading "Bid Challenge and Recourse Mechanisms" contains information on potential complaint bodies such as:

- Office of the Procurement Ombudsman (OPO)
- Canadian International Trade Tribunal (CITT)

2.6.3 Offerors should note that there are strict deadlines for filing complaints, and the time periods vary depending on the complaint body in question. Offerors should therefore act quickly when they want to challenge any aspect of the procurement process.

B. RESULTING CONTRACT CLAUSES

Add: 6.8 Dispute Resolution

- 6.8.1 The parties agree to maintain open and honest communication about the Work throughout and after the performance of the contract.
- 6.8.2 The parties agree to consult and co-operate with each other in the furtherance of the contract and promptly notify the other party or parties and attempt to resolve problems or differences that may arise.
- 6.8.3 If the parties cannot resolve a dispute through consultation and cooperation, the parties agree to consult a neutral third party offering alternative dispute resolution services to attempt to address the dispute.
- 6.8.4 Options of alternative dispute resolution services can be found on Canada's Buy and Sell website under the heading "Dispute Resolution".

G5 Basis of Selection

Basis of Selection - Highest Combined Rating of Technical Merit (70%) and Price (30%)

G5.1 To be declared responsive, a bid must:

- a. comply with all the requirements of the bid solicitation; and
- b. meet all mandatory criteria; and
- c. obtain the required minimum of 70 weighted points for the Total Technical Score for the point rated technical criteria.

Responsive offer will be evaluated by per zone. Canada intends to award up to two Standing Offers per zone.

G5.2 Bids not meeting (a) or (b) or (c) will be declared non-responsive. Neither the responsive bid obtaining the highest number of points nor the one with the lowest evaluated price will necessary be accepted.

G5.3 The lowest evaluated price (LP) of all responsive bids will be identified and a pricing score (PS) determined as follows, will be allocated to each responsive bid: $PS = LP / P \times 30$. Pi is the evaluated price (P) of each responsive Bid.

G5.4 A technical merit score (TMS), determined as follows, will be allocated to each responsive bid: $TMS = OS / \text{Max Point} \times 70$. OS is the overall score (OS) obtained by each responsive bid for all the point rated technical criteria specified in Annex F, determined as follows: total number of points obtained / maximum number of points available.

G5.5 The combined rating (CR) of technical merit and price of each responsive bid will be determined as follows: $CR = PS + TMS$.

G5.5.1 An example listed below where all three bids are responsive and the selection of the contractor is determined by 70/30 ratio of technical merit and price, respectively.

Technical Formula: Total Merit Score = Overall Score / Max Point x 70% (TMS=OS / Max Point x 70%)
Price Formula: Pricing Score=Lowest Evaluated Price / Price x 30% (PS=LP / P x 30%)
Combined Rating= Pricing Score (PS) + Total Merit Score (TMS) (CR=PS + TMS)

G5.6 The selection will be based on the highest responsive combined rating of technical merit and price. The ratio will be 70% for the technical merit and 30% for the price. The responsive offer with the highest combined rating of technical merit and price will be recommended for award of a Standing Offer. Canada intends to award up to two Standing Offers per zone.
