This amendment is raised to provide information about changes to Bundle 7, and to respond to questions from industry.

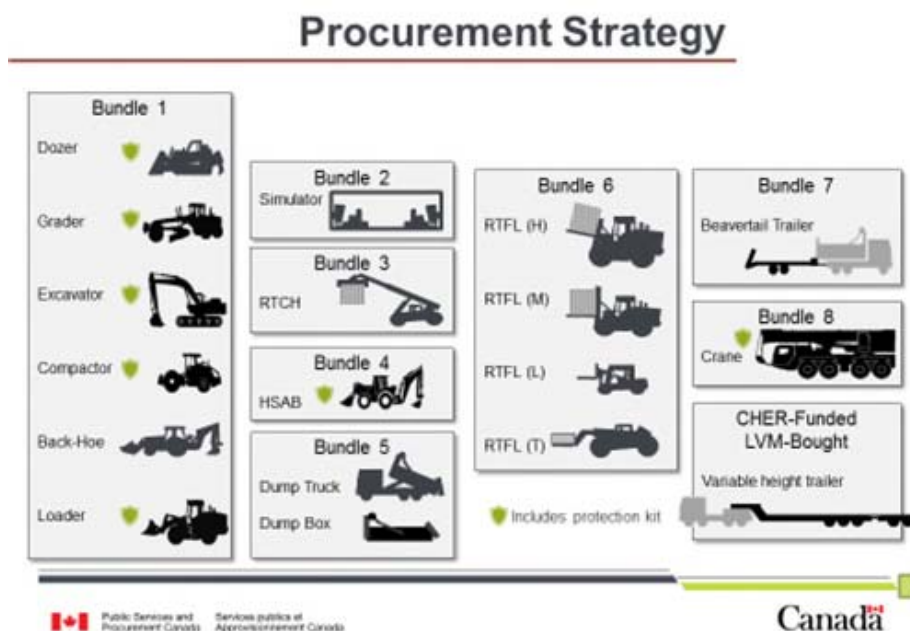
Bundle 7 – Beavertail trailers

The CHER project aims to deliver 8 variable height (lowbed) and 69 beavertail trailers as part of Bundle 7. However, due to the similarity of the requirements of two Department of National Defence's projects, which presents an opportunity for increased economies of scale, and more efficient life cycle management, the procurement of the variable height trailers will be achieved through the Logistics Vehicle Modernization (LVM) project (W847L-190122).

The procurement of the beavertail trailers will remain as group 7 under the CHER project.

Answers to Questions from Industry

Q1: Amendment 21 is requesting Industry to provide feedback to the latest recommendations for economic stimulus related to the project.

The Industrial and Technological Benefits (ITB) policy clearly falls within Innovation, Science, and Economic Development's (ISED) purview, however, the Canadian Content Policy (CCP) and Canadian Value Added Approach (CVAA) are Cabinet-mandated. Who will administer the compliance to CCP and CVAA?

A1: The Canadian Content Policy is a Cabinet-mandated policy and a link with the full explanation of this policy, including how a Canadian Content certification is evaluated and verified, is provided below:

The Canadian Value Added Approach is not a Cabinet-mandated policy, but it is a strategy we are considering for encouraging industrial development in Canada without limiting competition. Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC) would administer compliance.

Q2: Is there a reporting/monitoring element to CCP & CVAA or is it a go/no go criteria, one and done at proposal, and that's it. Who in Government receives the annual report (except ITBs)?

A2: We anticipate following the CCP approach of certification at the time of bidding, PWGSC may verify the certificate. We anticipate that the contract will include a Discretionary Audit clause for verification of claims during contract.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
