

Proposed Solution via vendor platform portal does have SOME WCAG compliance, but not all because of the function of how proposed solution online assessments work. We have provided the VPAT this platform.

In the first paragraph at the very end, we have inserted the words ", as applicable to the Statement of Work for Vendor Solution." This is because as stated before, not all WCAG requirements apply to proposed solution.

For the limited purpose of Vendor's online employee assessments, which is the product offered in the RFP, Vendor Solution via Vendor's Digital Product Suite, Canadian Government's "Guideline On Making Information Technology Usable By All" and "Accessibility Strategy for the Public Service of Canada," Solution has WCAG 2.0 compliance as described in the attached copy of Vendor's VPAT dated as of April 2019 (revised) solely for client employee users who take the online assessment.

The VPAT does NOT apply to client employee admin users in the self-service option of Vendor Solution.

However, we are unable to remediate this specific matter for admin users in the self-service option of Vendor Solution. Of course, if there is a specific need by Canadian Government, we are happy to discuss those. Other than our VPAT, Vendor cannot comply with all of the technical requirements in clause 5 because they do not necessarily apply to our online offerings. Of course, Shared Services Canada and Vendor's engagement team can discuss other accessibility methods that will accomplish the goals of the final negotiated statement of work.

Since Covid -19 hit we have deliver training virtually to hundreds of federal government employees in private group sessions and again have not required reliable security status. Instructors don't generally have any information on students — the vendor would have that information and they would have the DOS security clearance.

The security requirements associated with this contract cannot be modified.

## **Question 52**

As we were reviewing to submit we noticed what we believe to be an error in the RFP.

The problem is the Bid Evaluated Price is calculated by adding the average <u>unit cost</u> of assessments and courses without consideration of the <u>Estimated Usage</u>. This will cause major implications on procurement for Shared Services .

For example: bid evaluated price is \$5,045 (5000+45), which would result in a contract total of \$365,000 (7000x45 + 5000x10). If you changed the test unit cost to \$150 and the course unit cost to \$10, your Bid Evaluated Price would \$160, but the contract total would be \$1,150,000

This was somewhat raised in the below question but until we calculated the math we didn't see it.

Question 36 of the RFP Amendments raised the issue somewhat: My question concerns the calculation of the pricing score (PS), specifically on the Evaluated Bid Price (Pi). It goes on to demonstrate the math, but doesn't raise the obvious disparity in the eventual Contract Total based on the Estimated Usage. The SSC answer was: The evaluated bid price is as follows: D1 + D2 as indicated in ATTACHMENT 1 TO PART 3 - PRICING SCHEDULE.

We request an amendment to the Pricing Schedule and delay in the submission deadline.

This is not an error. The estimated usage column for the services is used to assist bidders in providing the All Inclusive Rate per test and the all inclusive rate per training course for each contract period, as indicated in ATTACHMENT 1 to PART 3, PRICING SCHEDULE.

The amount indicated in the Estimated Usage column represents the "estimated total usage" for the Initial Contract Period and all optional periods.

## As per 1.4 Volumetric Data:

The inclusion of volumetric data in this document is for reference purposes only and does not represent a commitment by Canada that Canada's future usage of the services described in the bid solicitation will be consistent with this data.

The RFP extension will not be granted.
