Question and Answers

**Q2: Does a vendor have to be able to offer all of the training courses in order to be considered for award?**

A2: As per Part 4 Evaluation Procedures and Basis of Selection, article 4.2.1.2, "The Responsive Offer with the lowest 'Stream Total per Group' will be recommended for SO issuance as further described in Attachment 2 to Part 4 Pricing Schedule."

For clarity, this means a contractor would need to provide the lowest cost for at least 1 Stream (e.g. STREAM 1: Forklift Training) in 1 Group (e.g. Group A: CSC Institutions for SK North), and meet all other requirements of the Request for Standing Offers document, to be considered for the issuance of a Standing Offer.

**Q3a. Can you explain how a 16 hour training period would work around incarceration time? Would the 16 hour training period include lunch breaks and other activities mandatory for a prison population?**

A3a. Correctional Service Canada will make minimum security offenders available for 8 hours of training per day. Exact hours of training each day can be finalized between the contractor and a individual site a when training session is being booked. Medium security offenders can be made available for 6 hours of training per day, so an additional day of training will be required. Each training will be comprised of a cohort of offenders from only one security level. Contractors will be notified at time of booking.

**Q3b. Would the 16 hour training period include lunch breaks and other activities mandatory for a prison population?**

A3b. A lunch break would be in addition to the training period. However, CSC will make offenders available for training for the number of hours/day stated in the answer to Question 3a.

**Q4. Section 7.2.2 states that each trainer must hold a DOS with a Reliability Status prior to training. Do vendors need to have this prior to submitting proposals or can the status be obtained after award?**
