## **This Solicitation Amendment 003 is raised to answer bidders' questions 11 to 14**

### **Q11:**

Would the RCMP be willing to accept a product that meets and exceeds the technical requirement but has a different crimping technology that improves accuracy, performance and the ballistic coefficient of the bullet?

### **A11:**

Projectile Crimp- The RCMP is willing to accept any type of crimping providing that the product meets all the performance requirements stated in the Statement of Requirement.

Primer Crimp- The RCMP is willing to accept any type of crimp providing that there is physical evidence that it is crimped and that it meets all the performance requirements stated in the Statement of Requirement.

### **Q12:**

Will RCMP supply a source to get support in purchasing Noveske 8.2 and 14.5 in. 1:7 twist barrels?

### **A12:**

It is the bidder's responsibility to acquire any equipment or support for equipment they deem necessary to bid on this solicitation. To the RCMP's knowledge, Gravel Agency has been known to provide support for the Noveske 8.2 and 14.5 in. 1:7 twist barrels.

The RCMP is not recommending or endorsing this supplier nor is the RCMP confirming that this supplier continues to provide support for the Noveske barrels

### **Q13:**

Will RCMP please verify the required Temperature Range? The solicitation currently requires suppressed and unsuppressed function in semi-automatics from -71° F to 131° F. We would recommend raising the extreme cold temperature to at least -40° F (-40° C).

### **A13:**

The required temperature range is +55° C (+131° F) to -57° C (-71° F). The RCMP will not change this requirement.

### **Q14:**

The RFP doesn't state if the lowest evaluated price will be on an "item to item basis" or "aggregate basis". Seeing that the lead free round has already been segregated from the other two, would Canada consider segregating these two rounds as well or at minimal amending the clause to read "an Item to item basis"?
