- 1. Architectural Addendum Concrete Splash Pads at Downspout Locations:
  - .1 On Sheet A3, the note on the Plan of Existing Building drawing that currently reads:


    "SAWCUT AND REMOVE EXISTING ASPHALT AS REQUIRED TO INSTALL
    305mmx610mmx75mm THICK CONCRETE SPLASH PAD AT DOWNSPOUT (TYP.
    FOR 8 LOCATIONS)"

shall be replaced with the following:

"SUPPLY AND INSTALL 305mmx610mmx75mm THICK CONCRETE SPLASH PAD AT DOWNSPOUT. CONCRETE SPLASH PAD TO BE SHIMMED LEVEL WITH POLYPROPYLENE PLASTIC STRIPS OR WEDGES AS APPROPRIATE (TYP. FOR 8 LOCATIONS)."

- 2. Structural Addendum Concrete Work Site Conditions:
  - .1 On Sheet S1 under the heading "CONCRETE", the following items shall be added:
    - ".10 Placing concrete during rain or weather events that could damage concrete is prohibited.
    - .11 Protect newly placed concrete from rain or weather events in accordance with CSA A23.1/A23.2.
    - .12 Cold weather protection:
      - .1 Maintain protection equipment in readiness on Site.
      - .2 Use such equipment when ambient temperature below 5°C, or when temperature may fall below 5°C throughout the entirety of the concrete curing process.
      - .3 Placing concrete upon or against surface at temperature below 5°C is prohibited.
    - .13 Protect from drying."





## 3. Architectural Addendum – Door Hardware

- .1 The deadbolt shall be releasable from the inside by the panic bar (single action, duel release).
- .4 Architectural Addendum Door Hardware Keying
  - .1 On Sheet A5 under the new heading "Door Hardware Keying," the following should be added.
    - .1 Door locks to be as directed. Prepare detailed keying schedule in conjunction with Departmental Representative.
    - .2 Supply keys in duplicate for every lock in this Contract.
    - .3 Stamp keying code numbers on keys and cylinders.
    - .4 Supply construction cores.
    - .5 Hand over permanent cores and keys to Departmental Representative.
    - .6 Permanent door locks to be installed by D&M Locksmith Ltd., 154 Shaw Road, Brockville, ON, K6V 5T4. Website: <a href="http://www.dmlocksmith.com">http://www.dmlocksmith.com</a>. Office Telephone: 1 613.924.9408. Mobile: 1 613.349.2215.
- .5 Architectural Addendum Laminated Safety Glass
  - .1 All glazing at exterior windows and doors to be laminated tempered glass.
  - .2 Laminated glass: to CAN/CGSB-12.1, Category II, consisting of two layers of minimum 3 mm thick clear tempered glass, sandwiching a 0.8 mm thick clear PVB interlayer. Total thickness of 6.8 mm.
  - .3 Submit an extended warranty for Vinyl Operating Windows and Laminated Safety Glazing Work in accordance with General Conditions, except that warranty period is extended to five (5) years.
    - .1 Warrant against failure to meet the design criteria and requirements such as interior leakage, insulating glass unit failure, finish degradation, frame condensation.
    - .2 Coverage: Complete replacement including affected adjacent Work.
