The following are effective immediately and form part of the contract documents.

Questions and Answers

Q1: Can you confirm the Coordinates of the old structure needs to be removed? Is it next to the new structure?

A1: Approximate coordinates of the abandoned structure is 49°9'35.13"N, 122°58'49.04"W. It is approximately 100m NE of the Front Range.

Q2: Do we have any access from the land or beach to remove the structure?

A2: Access is to be by water. However, temporary impacts to the environment are permissible provided they do not cause a Harmful Alteration, Disruption or Destruction (HADD) of Fish Habitat. The barge can be grounded, and equipment can be walked onto the shore. Works must have as least impact to the environment as possible.

Q3: Can we dredge pocket for barge for accessibility?

A3: No permanent alterations to the environment are permitted.

Q4: Will land based access be permitted via the adjacent public road and will equipment be permitted to track along the foreshore?

A4: Contractor must access by water. Equipment can track along the shore from a barge if environmental mitigation measures are employed to provide the least interaction with the environment as possible.
