Amendment 001

This amendment is being raised to answer bidder questions and to make additions to the tender package.

A. Bidder Questions

Q1. Section 2.2 talks about the migratory bird window. Does this window include raptors and owls and other birds/wildlife? I.e., if the work is completed before April 15th, does that mean that we will not be required to do raptor and/or owl sweeps?

A1. A bird sweep will not be required before the April 15th timeline. If the majority of the vegetation is removed before the April 15th deadline and only the remnants (e.g. pokers) remain to be removed within the bird window, a bird sweep is not required. However, if whole plants are to be removed during the bird window, a sweep will be required by a qualified environmental professional, no greater than 5 days prior to plant removal.

Q2. Are there any other species that will require any types of sweeps?

A2. No other wildlife sweeps will be required other than a bird sweep, as mentioned above.

Q3. In section 3.4 it stats that "off-road mechanical equipment must have tire pressure of 7 psi or lower." Is tracked equipment with a ground pressure of under 7 psi also acceptable?

A3. Yes, this is acceptable.

Q4. Are the results of the Archaeological Overview Assessment currently available? If so, could you provide them? If not, will they be available to us for us to include in our EPP before the start of the project?

A4. The full AOA report is not available at this time. However, mitigations from the AOA for specific locations will be restricted to vegetation removal by hand and no Ditch cleaning/grubbing in the following locations or location size. Exact locations will be flagged on-site by the Departmental Representative

- Lake Minnewanka Scenic Drive: A 165 continuous lineal metre section will be restricted to hand removal.

- Tunnel Mountain Road: 100 continuous lineal metre section Adjacent to Tunnel mountain trail Parking lot will be restricted to hand removal.
