1) Questions from industry

Question 12: Category 1a: The labeling of the Panel Matrix does not match the labeling of the panels on the floor plan. (For example, the panels on the Matrix are "Type A, Type 1B, etc.", and the panels are on the plan are "48 + FPS4"). Can the floor plans be updated with the corresponding labels, so that we can know where each panel type is desired to go?

Answer 12: Please refer to document WS-4 Typical Workstations for sections 213 and 232: 9_Montclair_Typical_WS-4_Rev.pdf and view desired workstation picture: desired_workstation_example_2.jpg for panel style. For the 120 degree panels, please refer to WS-2 Typical Workstations for section 217: 9_Montclair_Typical_WS-2_Rev.pdf

Question 13: Category 1a: All the panels in the matrix show fabric in the upper elements, however the desired photographs provided show glazed elements. Please advise if the panel matrix needs to change to included glazed elements?

Answer 13: Yes, the panel matrix needs to change to include glazed elements.

Question 14: Category 1a: The stations in area 232 & 213, appear to show glass blades (panel mounted privacy screens) on top of the panels, however there are none listed in the product tables or on the panel matrix. Can the table be updated to include these products?

Answer 14: Yes, absolutely. View change in table Part I - Product Categories: 1a, 1b, 2 & 5 (Items 5, 6, 7, 8).

Question 15: Category 1a: What is the height of the ceiling above finished floor?

Answer 15: 104 in. Finished floor to ceiling.

Question 16: Category 1b to 6: The Legends have furniture tags, but it is not clear which GoCUIDs these are to correspond with, as many of the descriptions do not match the size/details. Can the Product Tables be updated with the furniture tags so that we might match the product appropriately?

Answer 16: Tags were added to the product tables. GoCUID takes precedence over the legend.

Question 17: Category 1B – Item #3: This GoCUID does not match either the size or description on the Legend. Should we follow the GoCUID or the Legend?

Answer 17: View revised document: 9_Montclair_Hub_Rev3.dwg. GoCUID takes precedence over the legend.

Question 18: Category 1B – Item #4: This GoCUID does not match either the size or description on the Legend. Should we follow the GoCUID or the Legend?

Answer 18: View revised document: 9_Montclair_Hub_Rev3.dwg. GoCUID takes precedence over the legend.

Question 19: Category 2 – Item #8: 1) The GoCUID for this item indicates Acrylic/Glass Frosted screens, while the notes on the Typical drawing indicate Fabric screens. Should we follow the GoCUID or the Typical?

Answer 19: Please follow the GoCUID for Acrylic/Glass Frosted screens.

Question 20: Category 2 – Item #8: In amendment 004 the quantity was changed to 10. However, by definition Modular Height Adjustable Benching are double sided units (see section, 1.6 Definitions, 8., 3: "When referring to 4-work-surface-long benching, the unit will have four (4) workstations side by side with a workstation in front of each station. 4-worksurface- long benching must be comprised of a total of eight (8) workstations."). Therefore, according to the floor plan the original quantity of 5 was correct. Using 10 sets of single sided benches would be NSA and would double up the electrical connections required. Can the quantity be changed back to 5?

Answer 20: The quantity has been changed back to 5.

Question 21: Category 5 – Item #1: Would you also accept GoCUID 5TLTDSKBAACUSBXXXXX with the AC & USB option?

Answer 21: Yes.

Question 22: Category 3 - Item # 1 & 2: 1): This GoCUID is for painted metal lockers. The legend says they are laminate. Should we follow the GoCUID or the Legend?

Answer 22: GoCUID takes precedence over the legend. The GOCUID has been changed to Laminate.

Question 23: Category 3 - Item # 1 & 2: The maximum height for a locker under this GoCUID is 54". Can this item be moved to NSA to meet the custom requirement of 71"?

Answer 23: No. Please provide highest locker height possible under SA.

Question 24: Category 6 - Part IV - Item # 3: The meeting table described in this GoCUID has a column in the center and 4 post legs at the corners. This would interfere with leg room in the center, and they are not easily moved by users. The floor plans and legend description indicate a Training Table would be better suited to the design. However, the extra requirements in the Legend "Table base must allow for seating on all sides with no knee obstructions" means the modesty panels would have to be removed and the power modules moved to the underside of the table.

Answer 24: GoCUID takes precedence over the legend. The GoCUID has been changed with new table style.

Question 25: Category 6 - Part IV - Item # 3: Daisy-chaining plug-in power modules is not permissible under the electrical code, they need to connect to floor monuments individually. To have one continuous power source for all the tables the layout would have to be fixed with a hard-wired base feed to connecting to the building supply.

Answer 25: Perfect, power them individually.

Question 26: Category 6 - Part IV - Item # 3: Can this table be moved to NSA to achieve the custom requirements? We could provide tables with 4-post legs that link together, and have under work surface power bars.

Answer 26: No longer required - See answer 24.

Question 27: Category 6 - Part V - Item # 1: Does this item correspond to furniture tag ST3? If yes, the legend reads 24", while the GoCUID is for 30". Should we follow the GoCUID or legend?

Answer 27: GoCUID takes precedence over the legend.

Question 28: Category 6 - Part V - Item # 2: Does this item correspond to furniture tag T5? The legend description reads 29" with no leg obstructions, while the GoCUID represents a 42" high table with end gables. Should we follow the GoCUID or legend?

Answer 28: I believe you are referring to line 4. GoCUID takes precedence over the legend.

Question 29: Category 6 - Part VI - Item # 3: The legend for the banquette asks for "low-back", but also asks for a minimum back height of 16". Can this GoCUID be changed to 6SBAINXXLUW1G19LMYN (mid-back) to meet these requirements and match the adjacent banquettes? The SA defines low-back as 8"-12" high, and mid-back as 12"-18" high.

Answer 29: Yes. GoCUID has been changed. GoCUID takes precedence over the legend.

Question 30: Category 6 - Part VI - Item # 8: Would you also accept GoCUID 6SSOTWXXLUW4XXXQNNN, Two Seater Sofa with Legs, as it provides the same function?

Answer 30: This item is for tag MB4 which are the benches in the locker area. Canada has changed the GoCUID to put 2 benches together to match the width of 3 lockers so we have doubled the quantity. If you have another choice to offer, Canada is open to a better bench solution.

Question 31: Category 6 - Part VII – floor plans: The floorplan shows "BS1" bar stools arranged around standard height tables. There are no "KC1" kitchenette chairs on the floor plan. Should the chairs in the kitchen be standard height? Can you please indicate which areas have plastic chairs and which areas have wood chairs?

Answer 31: View specific tags for chairs (BS1-BPH, BS1-BPS and BS1-PH, BS1-PS) on revised plan: 9_Montclair_Hub_Rev3.dwg. Please refer to original GoCUID. GoCUID takes precedence over the legend.

Question 32: Category 6 - Part VII – Item #1: Would you also accept

GoCUID 6KBSBHxxSP15XXXRONX, Bar Height, Bent Plywood Chair with a Sled base, as it provides the same function?

Answer 32: No. Please refer to original GoCUID. GoCUID takes precedence over the legend.

Question 33: Category 6 - Part VII – Item #2: Would you also accept GoCUID 6KKCSAxxSP16XXXMONX, Standard Height, Bent Plywood Chair with a Sled base, as it provides the same function?

Answer 33: No. Please refer to original GoCUID. GoCUID takes precedence over the legend.

Question 34: Category 6 - Part VIII – Item #4: Would you also accept GoCUID 6OPLWLFLXC3H46XYTA, with 4 post legs as it provides the same function?

Answer 34: No. Please refer to original GoCUID. GoCUID takes precedence over the legend.


