This amendment is being raised to answer bidder questions.

A. Bidder Questions

Q5. A large portion of the proposed work is in areas that are currently closed off with barricades. Will access be possible to view these areas?

A5. Access is limited by foot or other permitted means. You may also use Google earth to acquire a representation of the brush density.

Q6. In order to meet contract requirements, primarily the removal of danger trees and Migratory Bird Act requirements, it will be necessary to complete tree removals before April 15. Therefore, will the Minnewanka Loop Road be opened, not later than February 28?

A6. Trees may be hand- fallen while the road is closed and removed once the road is opened on May 1. Or trees and brush removal can take place after the road is opened and before June 15th, using a qualified environmental professional (QEP) to assess the area prior to removal.

Q7. Where is the proposed ditch clean out supposed to happen?

A7. Ditch cleanout will be throughout the Minnewanka loop totaling 1600 linear metres. This exact location will be determined in the field by the Departmental representative.
