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**Amendment 008 is raised to answer questions from industry.**

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**Question 36:** In response to Amendment 006, the panel matrix has not been updated to match the typical drawings (9\_Montclair\_Typical\_WS-4\_Rev.pdf). Therefore we cannot know how tall each of the panels should be. Does Canada want a 36" base panel with a 15" glass black to achieve a total seated privacy height of 51"? Or at 51" panel with a 9" blade, or 15" blade?

**Response 36:** Requires a 36" base panel with a 15" frosted glass to achieve a total seated privacy height of 51".

**Question 37:** The photographs labeled "desired\_workstation\_example\_3" shows framed glass elements, which are not on the original panel matrix. Is this photograph now irrelevant to the design?

**Answer 37:** Framed glass elements are required. Photograph is still accurate.

**Question 38:** Cat.1b - Items A,B,C,D, & #11: All of the sizes and quantities of these items indicate from the design the screens should be panel mounted. However the GoCUIDS listed are for desk mounted screens. Having desk mounted screens provides several problems in this design:

- a) glass is very heavy, and this weight on a Height-Adjustable table will affect its performance, and possibly exceed its capacity depending on what other equipment is also placed on the table
- b) If the screens were to be mounted on top of the worksurface, then the clamp-mounted monitor arms and power modules could not be installed. Conversely if the screens were to be mounted on the edge of the tables, then a much larger gap would be required and the tables would be pushed out so that they aren't completely enclosed in a workstation. (the weight issues apply in both cases)

Should the GoCUIDs be changed to panel mounted screens (1bCPSXXNXXL24XFRNNN, 1bCPSXXNXXL30XFRNNN, 1bCPSXXNXXL42XFRNNN, 1bCPSXXNXXL48XFRNNN) and change the description on the NSA screen? How tall should the screen be above the solid panel?

**Answer 38a):**

SA technical specification requirements:

- The SA allows work surface mounted privacy screens to be provided in upholstered, **frosted acrylic or frosted safety glass** (excluding wired glass); so the weight of these finishes has been taken into account already under the SA.
- In addition, height adjustable tables have been tested against ANSI/BIFMA performance standards where the weight loads tested would surely exceed the additional weights of privacy screens, monitors and whatever computer equipment would be used.

**Answer 38b):** The SA is written so that clients can choose these options together. Even RPS recommends using a clamp-mounted monitor arm + clamp mounted privacy screens on a HAT table. Screen height is as per the GoCUID.
