A. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

- .1 Regarding article 3.11 of Ponceau RF_002, the relocation of electrical conduits (provisional):

Should we plan to replace the power cables if they are too short for the new route? if so, by how much?

- .1 Answer: If the power cables are too short, a change directive will be issued during the work. You don't have to plan to move these just yet. However, the power cables must be supported and protected during the work.

On plan 0001 we notice that there appear to be draft shafts upstream of the culvert, is this the case? Can we make a junction in this well?

- .2 Answer: No information is available as to whether there are any junction boxes. Should we provide a by-pass between Boul. Des Forges and the fire hydrant near the intersection with the Parc Canada Agency building?
