AMENDMENT 001

The purpose of Amendment 001 is to extend the solicitation period by one week and to respond to Bidders questions.

1) Solicitation Closes

New solicitation closing date is 26 January 2021 at 2:00 PM EST.

2) Questions and Answers related the Request for Proposal.

Question 1: SOW paragraph 5.1.3 indicates a possible quarantine prior to entering a Canadian Forces Facility. Does this mean the quarantine must be in a hotel (i.e. without any movement around Canada or Toronto)? If so will DND determine the hotel or may I select one of my choice?

Response 1: There are differences between the quarantine rules of accessing a Canadian Forces base and entering Canada. Prior to entering a Canadian Forces Base, all individuals must quarantine for 14 days. This is stricter than the federal health guidelines for essential workers which are exempt from quarantine upon entry to Canada. Please see the following site for up to date information applicable to essential workers: https://www.publicsafety.gc.ca/cnt/ntnl-scrt/crtcl-nfrstrctr/esf-sfe-en.aspx. Essential workers include "Personnel working for companies and their subcontractors, who perform under contract to Canada for the provision of materials and services for the Department of National Defence" as indicated at the following site: https://www.canada.ca/en/public-health/services/publications/diseases-conditions/covid-19-information-essential-service-workers.html. The Contractor may choose their hotel. Reimbursement will be in accordance with paragraph 7.7.6, Travel and Living Expenses.

Question 2: Annex B to SOW para 1.2. Is this the estimated cost of travel for the entire 5 years or just for a portion of total travel? There is no location in the RFP to itemise travel expenses.

Response 2: The evaluated price excludes the price of travel. The estimated cost of travel listed in Annex B, Basis of Payment is the estimated cost for the initial contract period.

Question 3: The Security Requirements Checklist is corrupted and impossible to read in some areas. Can you repost the SRCL?

Response 3: The SRCL is attached.

Question 4: In reference to Attachment 2 to Part 4 Pricing Schedule, Part 2, Per Diem Rates for TIES. How were the estimated number of days derived? When the Pricing Schedule is compared to SOW 3.2.3 there certainly appears to be more work than can be done in the number of days listed.

Response 4: This number is an estimate. The inclusion of volumetric data in the pricing schedule does not represent a commitment by Canada that Canada's future usage of the services described in the bid solicitation will be consistent with this data.

Question 5: Can you please specify in detail the SACC Manual Clauses referred to in the RFP or supply a copy of the SACC Manual?

Response 5: In Request for Proposal (RFP), Section 2.1 provides a website for bidders to review Standard Instructions, Clauses and Conditions. The RFP provided website is correct: https://buyandsell.gc.ca/policy-and-guidelines/standard-acquisition-clauses-and-conditions-manual.

Question 6: In reference to RFP Paragraph 1.2.4, refers to an "acknowledgement letter, attached at Annex D". Annex D contains a copy of "DND 626 Task Authorization Form"

Response 6: The Embedded Contractor Letter of Acknowledgement is attached at Annex F.

Question 7: In reference to RFP page 13 items MT1 & MT2 is conflicting as it suggests that two course outlines are to be supplied, one based on Transport Canada TP9685 and one based on ICAO 9625 or FAA part 60. For clarification, TP9685 is based on ICAO 9625. We suspect that you only require one course outline that includes references to TP9685, ICAO 9625 and FAA part 60. Also, should EASA CS-FTSD be included?

Response 7: Canada does require one course outline and not two. The course outline must reference either TP9685, ICAO 9625, FAA part 60 or EASA CS-FTSD.

Question 8: In reference to RFP page 13 items MT1 & MT2 does not identify which revision of TP9685, ICAO 9625 and FAA part 60 the course outlines are to refer to. Please clarify. If you add EASA CS-FSTD to the requirements please specify which version of that you require.

Response 8: DND has reviewed the question and the following versions will be considered as acceptable:

- TP9685 Revision 3
- ICAO 9625 3rd edition or later editions
- FAA Part 60 (edition 2016)
- EASA CS-FSTD (either the initial issue or the 2nd issue for CS-FSTD(A) are acceptable)

Question 9: In reference to page 14 item MT4 states that "The bidder must adapt an existing simulator evaluation course to the C130J flight simulator and simulated training devices located at AMTC in Trenton, Ontario". The Method of Compliance would suggest you are requesting the bidder to adapt one of their courses, but it could be construed that you are asking the bidder to adapt a course that currently exists at AMTC Trenton?

Response 9: The bidder's existing course must only be adapted to the necessary extent to use the C130J simulators available in Trenton as training aids for the practical portion of the curriculum. Minimal adaptation is expected, as Canada will furnish both the simulator and the IOS operator to support the practical portion of the curriculum.

Question 10: In reference to page 14 item MT4. To provide a course specifically for the C130J Flight Simulation Training Devices (FSTDs) requires details of the equipment, such as;

- a) its configuration;
- b) the primary Qualification document;
- c) its current Qualification level;
- d) the ability to conduct manual (pilot flown) as well as automatic validation tests;
- e) does it have an MQTG that meets current regulatory authority requirements?
- f) what is the capabilities of the auto testing utility assuming one exists?
- g) what is its configuration control system?
- h) and other items that would normally be found in a MQTG and/or letter of application for an initial qualification.

Response 10: In response to the Bidder's question, Canada will provide the attachments for items a, b, c and h by email to all Bidders who have thus far indicated an interest to this solicitation. These documents will be supplied to any interested party by submitting a request to the Contracting Authority indicated on page 1 of this RFP.

- a) its configuration; Attached documents refer.
- b) the primary Qualification document; Attached documents refer.
- c) its current Qualification level; Attached documents refer.
- d) the ability to conduct manual (pilot flown) as well as automatic validation tests. Response to item d: Manual and automated QTGs are both available.

- e) does it have an MQTG that meets current regulatory authority requirements Response to item e: **Yes.**
- f) what is the capabilities of the auto testing utility assuming one exists?
 Response to item f: Full set of automated QTGs, with a sub-set that can also be conducted manually.
- g) what is its configuration control system? Response to item g: To be determined.
- h) and other items that would normally be found in a MQTG and/or letter of application for an initial qualification. **Attached docs refer.**

Question 11: In reference to page 14 item MT7. As an individual, a student graduating from a course will not be able to perform all of the tasks required to Evaluate and Qualify a FSTD. The Evaluation and Qualification of FSTDs is a team effort due to workload and SME requirements. Most NAAs will propose a minimum team of 4 for an initial evaluation, and 3 for a recurrent evaluation to cover all of the skills and knowledge to perform the tasks required. The team is usually split into a pilot inspector, a technical inspector, a FSTD operator, and in the case of initial evaluations, a Quality System inspector who evaluates/audits all of the Operators CMS related criteria.

Response 11: Understood. The course graduates will expected to be able to competently fulfill at least one of these four roles.

Question 12: As a comment to MT7 which states that an exam must be provided that establishes a student's capability to perform a formal FSTD evaluation. An exam can be provided to evaluate a student's ability to perform their role in an Evaluation and Qualification, as a team member, but even then the graduating student will require additional experience as part of team before they could be considered capable of taking a lead role in such.

Response 12: Understood. The exam must verify the students' knowledge component, rather than their complete capability to evaluate a simulator or their complete ability to fulfil a particular role in the evaluation team.

Question 13: In reference to page 16 item PRT3. Are you asking if the bidder has experience performing initial acceptance specifically for and on behalf of DND, or experience performing initial acceptance on newly procured FSTDs for anybody? Also, are you asking about specifically acceptance testing vs. initial evaluation and qualification of a FSTD? They are two separate processes.

Response 13: The bidder must demonstrate experience performing initial acceptance on newly procured FSTDs for any client. Canada requires resources with experience in the initial evaluation and qualification of a FSTD. Canada understands that the testing vs. initial evaluation and qualification of a FSTD are two separate processes. DND typically conducts both processes simultaneously.

Question 14: In reference to page 36 items 3.2.2.2 & 3.2.2.3 which presuppose the duration of the course will be 9 days (each) when the content of the course has yet to be established. Like any professional and modern training organization we teach and evaluate students based on measurable criteria considering pre-requisites (if any), and the desired (performance) outcome. There may also be a requirement to break the training into parts, possibly with distance learning for the first part, so that experience may be gained (OJT) prior to the second part and completion of the course. Can you please supply full details of the skills and knowledge of the students that will be attending the course, and what roles you expect them to play in the Evaluation and Qualification of your FSTDs?

Response 14: DND's intent is to have the bidder adapt an existing course so that it can be delivered using DND facilities; this adaptation should require minimal changes. Graduates of this course are expected to perform initial qualification of newly-procured simulators and recurrent evaluation of existing simulators. Therefore, graduates are expected to fully understand the process of qualification, and be

able to perform the all of the tasks involved (e.g. QTG review, execution, and evaluation, as well as evaluation of cockpit fidelity. Piloting ability can be assumed). A profile of each student will be provided prior to a given course serial. The course duration of 9 days is an estimate and is not a requirement.

Question 15: In reference to page 36 item 3.2.2.2 & 3.2.2.3. Although in normal circumstances we can deliver our 6 day standard course, suitably modified, to a class size of 10 students starting 8th March 2021 and 17th Mar 2021. However, with the current COVID related situation of travel limitations and isolation requirements, and the restriction of group size gatherings, we currently think the dates are impractical and could not be firmly agreed to in a contract. Would Canada consider splitting each course into 2 parts? The first part covering the knowledge portion of our regular course could be done remotely with live instructors. The hands-on (skills) side of the training would take place at your location at a later date when it is deemed safe and allowable to do so.

Response 15: Given the current COVID-19 situation, Canada would consider splitting the course into two parts as described above. All courses will be held in a manner which is compliant to all public health measures in effect at the course's location.

Question 16: Will Canada consider an extension to the initial closing date by at least one month?

Response 16: Canada has provided time to Industry to familiarize themselves with the requirement via the RFI posted earlier followed by the one-to-one interviews. There is very little deviation from the RFI to the RFP. As a show of good faith, Canada will extend the solicitation period to 26 January 2021.

By receiving this permission to access controlled material within DND when such access is required, you are under an obligation to comply with all elements of the DAOD 3003-1 with respect to the handling and safeguarding of controlled goods. You are also required to complete all applicable training on controlled goods.

As an "embedded contractor" in DND, you are not permitted to disclose controlled goods or technical data to anyone other than authorized DND personnel who have a need to know, and have a minimum SECRET level clearance. This includes other individuals who have been identified as embedded contractors. You MUST NOT disclose or transfer controlled goods including controlled technical data to any outside third parties, including the company employing you or contracting for your services, unless authorized by the CTAT Office. Non-compliance with the terms of the DAOD 3003-1 and this letter may result in the denial to access controlled goods/technical data and/or may be considered a default under your current contract and may be subject to violations under the *Defence Production Act* (DPA).
