Amendment 002

This amendment is being raised to extend the solicitation closing date, to distribute questions and answers and provide new information.

A. Bid Closing Date

The closing date for tender 5P420-20-0330/A is extended from January 28, 2021 to **February 2, 2021 at 2:00PM Mountain Standard Time (MST)**.

B. Question and Answer

Q3: Will Target Flowcrete with Fume Grout be accepted as CX-L concrete for this project?

A3: As per Section 01 33 00 – Submittal Procedures, and 03 30 00 – Cast-in-Place Concrete, the Contractor is responsible to submit concrete mix designs as a part of the Construction Phase Submittals. Upon submission the concrete mix design will be reviewed for compliance with the Contract documents.

Q4: Will the Vulcan Moveable Barrier system be an accepted temporary barrier?

A4: As per Section 01 33 00 – Submittal Procedures, and 01 55 26 – Traffic Control, the Contractor is responsible to submit a Traffic Management Plan (TMP) as a part of the Pre-Mobilization Submittals. Upon submission of the TMP, the proposed temporary barrier will be reviewed for compliance with the TMP and Contract documents.

Q5: I am pricing the gabion construction on this project, and there does not appear to be a specific rock chosen for the gabion walls, however, there appears to be a Structure Design stone chosen. Sorry but I can't seem to get clarification from the GC's. Can you help?

A5: As per Section 01 33 00, the Contractor is to submit detailed design drawings for design of gabion retaining wall at Beaver River Bridge, including installation procedure and any temporary support structures. Design to be stamped and signed by a professional engineer registered or licensed in the Province of British Columbia, Canada. A specific rock has not been defined in the Contract Documents, however the physical properties and size shall satisfy the requirements of clause 2.1.1.5 of Section 31 36 00 – Gabions. For clarification clause 2.1.1.5.3 indicates that the stone fill material used in construction of the gabion structure shall match the stone fill material specified in the detailed design drawings prepared by the Contractor.

C. New Information

The Kicking Horse Canyon Project Phase 4 construction will require an extended multi-day closure of the Trans-Canada Highway (TCH) east of Golden, BC from April 12 to May 14, 2021. Traffic will be routed via Highways 93 and 95, which will lengthen travel time significantly on this route.
